### Item 3. Dynamic and new sectors of world trade: The South–South dimension

The expert meeting aims to elucidate: (a) new and dynamic sectors of trade globally (in the world and within the South), regionally and locally (for developing countries); (b) what those new and dynamic sectors among the South show with respect to the growing importance of the South in the international economic landscape; (c) how entering into new and dynamic sectors could ultimately lead to meeting a country's long-term development goals; and (d) interaction between growth of new and dynamic sectors and trade networking among the South via bilateral, regional and inter-regional trade agreements, economic cooperation, evolution of new global value chains, and a trade–investment–technology transfer nexus.
