**Results of the readership survey among member States
on UNCTAD's publications issued in 2000-2001**

1. The UNCTAD secretariat, as a part of its publications policy, regularly seeks feedback on the usefulness and impact of its publications. The annual readership survey among its membership has been a standard feature of this policy. Further, one of the indicators of achievement contained in the medium-term plan of UNCTAD, as approved by the Trade and Development Board at its twenty-fourth executive session, is the usefulness and the quality of research and analysis “as measured by readership and other surveys”. In this context, the views of member States on UNCTAD’s publications issued during the 2000-2001 biennium were solicited.

2. The results of this survey are summarized below by publication or by series of publications. When a comment concerns one publication or one issue within a series, the respective publication/issue is indicated in brackets after the comment in question. The number of replies was only 14, but these were representative in terms of their distribution (7 from developing countries, 5 from developed countries, 2 from countries with transition economies)*.

Title: **Trade and Development Report**

Comments:

- Very informative and excellent analysis of issues of great importance, especially to policy makers.
- Good analysis and very informative.
- A poor competitor to *Global Economic Prospects* by World Bank. Not sure of the necessity in its current form.
- It is recommended that the Report analyses the situation of developing countries with small economies in particular.
- Specific inputs are to be used for decision-making in practical politics in the parliament. The publication can contribute to international negotiations and designation of the role of parliament in developing public policy. Information contained in the publication will be summarized for the parliamentarian's discussions, debate and negotiations in international conferences.
- Need prompt translation into languages for better dissemination.
- 2001 issue was deeply flawed, rife with outdated assumptions and unbalanced arguments. UNCTAD should stick to its core mandates of trade, investment and development for its flagship reports. (*TDR 2001*)
- Informative. However, previous issues had better quality. (*TDR 2001*)

- Informative with detailed statistics.
- Good approach addressing one major issue each year.
- The only source of some statistics on investment.
- Very useful data for further analysis.
- Huge effort to produce a good publication. Found to be useful both for the ministries (esp. science and technology, and production and commerce) and for Geneva discussions.
- Need translation into other languages.
- It could address two related issues, instead of one, each year to widen the scope of coverage.
- Good analysis and practical use for policy-making, but might have a wider coverage of the issue. (*WIR 2000*)
- Very informative with up-to-date data, topic that captures the current investment movement, and a lot of specific and concrete examples that benefits policy makers. (*WIR 2001*)
- Deepen the analysis especially the recommendation on best practices. Both pros and cons of each measure and success and failure stories should be cited. (*WIR 2001*)
- Useful summary of linkages, fitting well with OECD work on the investment benefits. Conveyed a helpful message for attracting FDI for countries in need. (*WIR 2001*)
