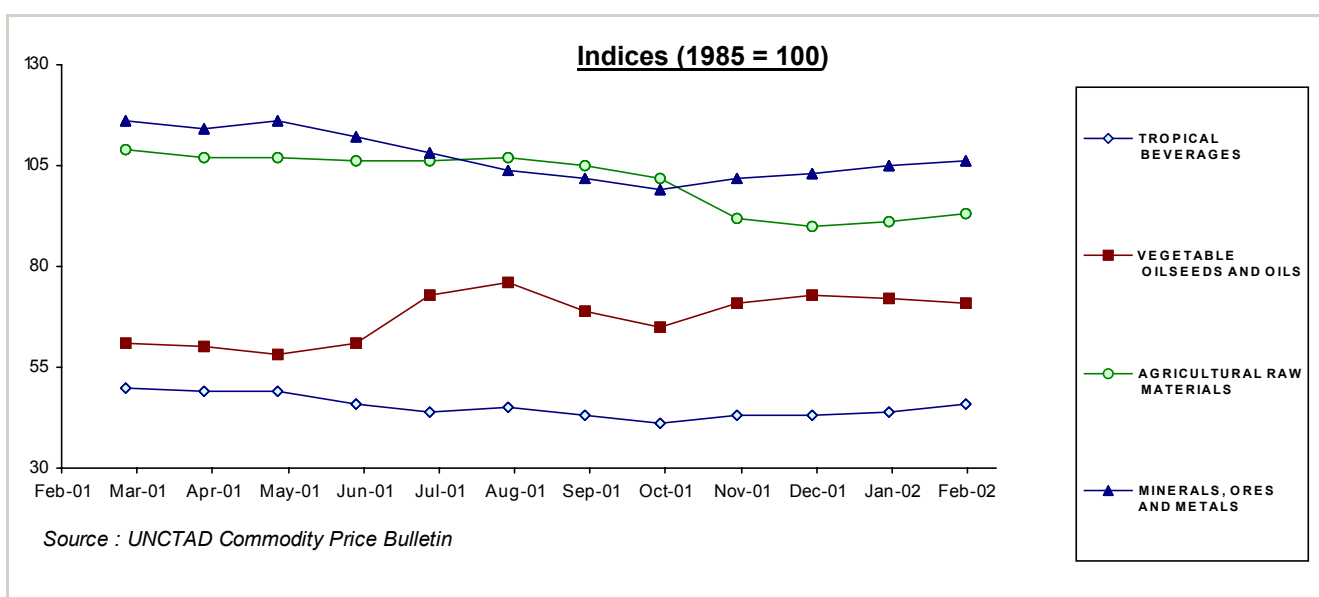

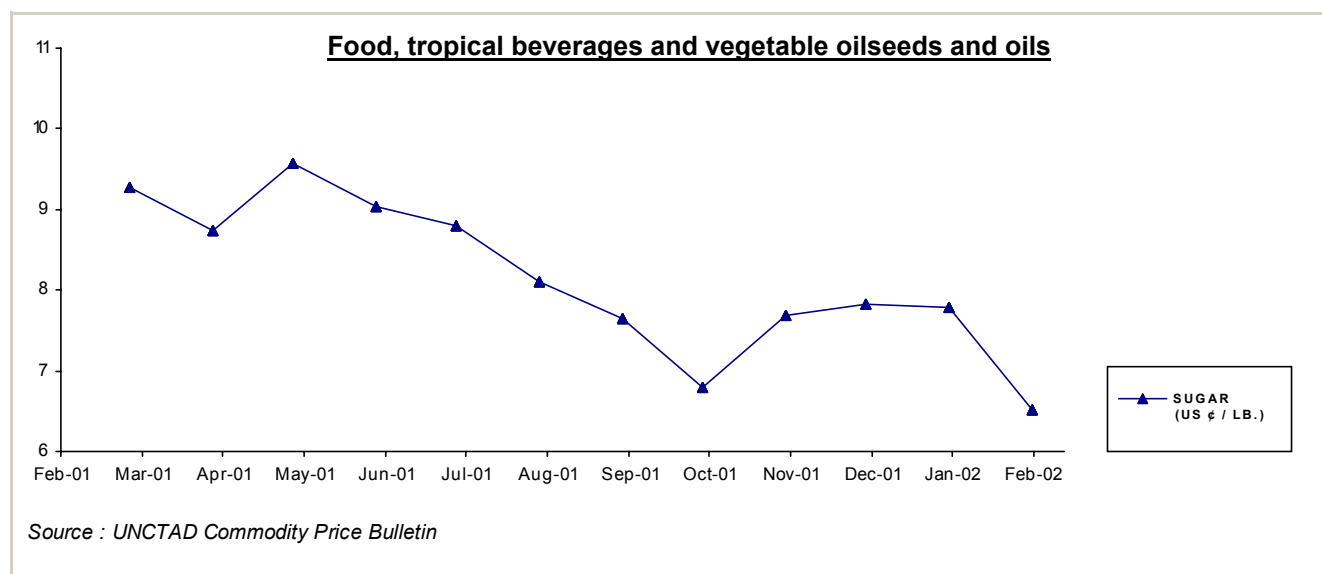

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Since the February 2002 Update of the Commodity Price Bulletin (CPB), the following new series have been introduced  in replacement of the discontinued series mentioned below:

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- \* Maize 3: Argentina, Rosario, F.O.B. (International Grains Council) replacing  Maize 1: Argentina, C.I.F., Rotterdam
- \* Wool 2: 19 micron, Australia (IMF) replacing Wool 1, UK Dominion, clean 64's (Dry-combed basis)
- \* Wool 4: 23 micron, Australia (IMF) replacing Wool 3, UK Dominion, clean 48's (Dry-combed basis)
- \* Rubber 3: TSR 20, New York, C.I.F. (International Rubber Study Group)

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As a result of the discontinuation of the series, monthly indices of free market prices have been recalculated, using the  series mentioned below:

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- \* ALL FOOD (Maize 2, US, N° 3, yellow, C.I.F. Rotterdam in replacement of Maize 1).
- \* FOOD (same as above)
- \* AGRICULTURAL RAW MATERIALS (Wool 2 and Wool 4 in replacement of Wool 1\$ and Wool 3\$, respectively)
- \* COMBINED INDEX IN TERMS OF CURRENT DOLLARS
- \* COMBINED INDEX IN TERMS OF SDR's

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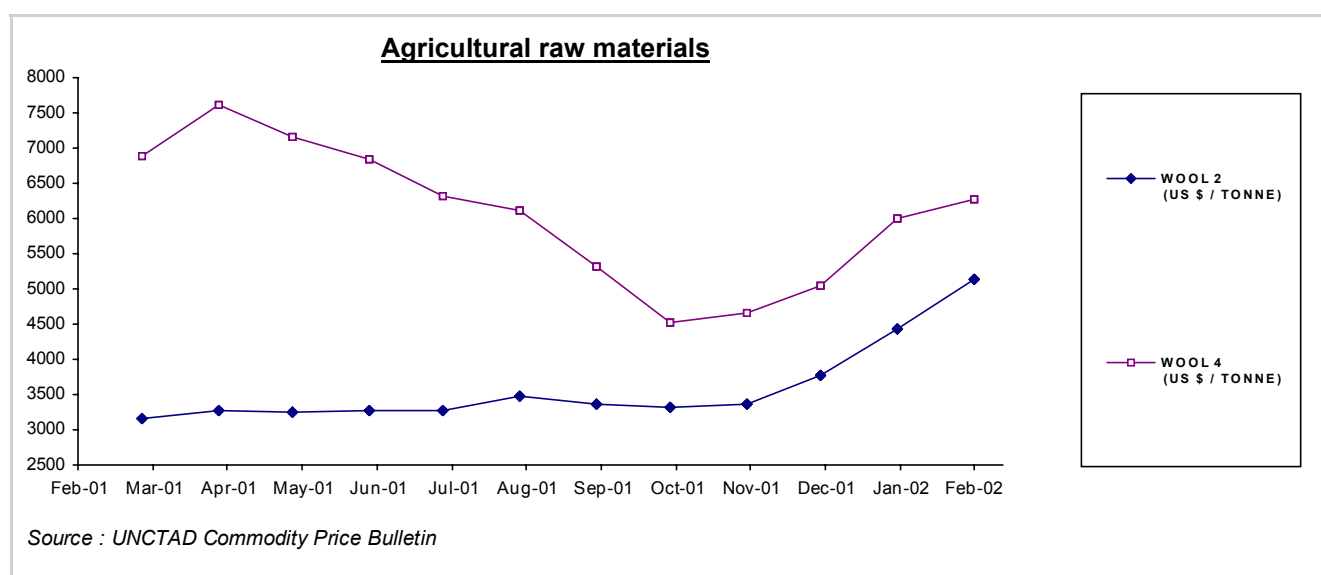

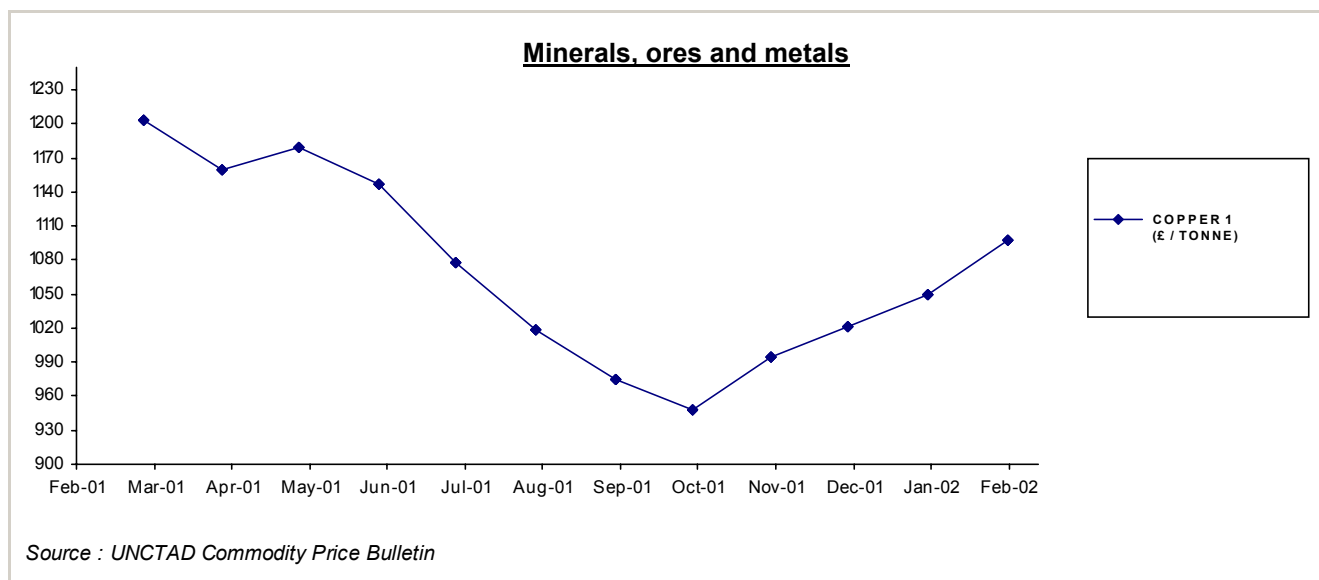
