

Step 1: What are NTMs, How to do a systematic mapping

- Develop and revise International Classification on NTMs: Common Language
 - MAST: FAO, IMF, ITC, OECD, UNCTAD, UNIDO, World Bank, WTO
 - Experts and other partner organisation
- Develop standardised approach to map NTMs
 - UNCTAD Guidelines to collect NTMs





 - Establised a network to collect NTMs data






