FINANCIAL MECHANISMS

- Investment in infrastructure development
- From dial-in to broadband; from fixed to mobile
- Digital Solidarity Fund
 - Concept never got real traction of scale
 - Management poor
 - Attempts to revive failed
- Capacity building as investment

- ICANN relationship with USG/ NTIA
 - Evolution: MoU Joint Project Agreement (2006) Affirmation of Commitment (2010)
 - > IANA function: Transition (2015)
- Introduction of IDNs
- Role of the GAC
 - Membership
 - Responsibilities and status
 - Engagement

INTERNET GOVERNANCE (2)

INTERNET GOVERNANCE (3)

- Internet Governance Forum multi-stakeholder discussion platform – created to inform the decision-making elsewhere
 - CSTD WG on IGF improvements
 - More tangible outcomes
 - Regional and national IGF initiatives (20)
- NETmundial and NETmundial Initiative

INTERNET GOVERNANCE (4)

- Enhanced cooperation compromise concept after the "New model of cooperation" proposal by the EU didn't find support
- Concept has changed meaning process leading towards enhanced cooperation has it led to enhanced cooperation?
- Multi-stakeholder or intergovernmental cooperation interpretation possible
- IGF part of enhanced cooperation or two distinct processes?
- CSTD WG on enhanced cooperation

INTERNET GOVERNANCE (5)

- Bridging digital divide developmental aspects of IG
- Access to Internet
 - Speed (broadband)
 - Price
- Technical competence/ capacity building
- Linguistic diversity
- Local content development

WSIS + 10 REVIEW

- Intergovernmental negotiations July-December 2015
- UN GA High Level meeting in December 2015
- PGA will appoint two lead negotiators
- Other stakeholders will be consulted
- Internet Governance will at the core of negotiations
 - Multi-stakeholder vs intergovernmental (multilateral)
 - Operationalization of enhanced cooperation
 - Extension of IGF mandate
