- + (amend) Plant Act B.E. 2535 (1992)

Plant Act

- 3 Sections and Sub law
- Define plants under CITES listed are conserved plants. (Ministerial Notification)
- Export, import or re-export have to ask CITES
 Permit (Department Notification)
- Propagated conserved plants have to register with Dept. of Agriculture (Department Notification)



Violation of international trade and do not registration

In prison 3 months Fine 3000 bath (100 dollars)



- Orchids
- Ornamental plants :- cacti, cycads, succulents, nepenthes
- Aquilaria crassna and A. malaccensis



-Minor forest product Orchids

Agarwood

- Plants from wild taken need license or permission from offices













- All aquilaria spp. Include in CITES App. II since 2010
- Department Notification : 1. maintain parent stock 2. propagate for production
- Enact Dept. Notification in 2015 in followin the change definition of artificially propagation for agarwood
- New registration system for agarwood (tree plant) has been set up
