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


### 1. The Internet is changing how trade is conducted

Average number of export destinations by Commercial Sellers on eBay, 2014



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
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### Firms can reach a larger customer base and achieve economies of scale






### The share of firms selling online has increased between 2009 and 2015





### Firms can be mobile and do not need to locate in high income and population dense regions






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### But firms are not taking advantage of these benefits




#### ECA countries have small shares of e-commerce sales compared to other countries





# Small firms are less able to take advantage of e-commerce






### Exports, especially to non-EU markets, are limited compared to domestic sales




Percentage of firms selling online by Destination, 2013









In Northern and Western Europe, more than 10 percent of workers telecommutes





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### Online freelancers can earn incomes equivalent to several times minimum wages...




#### Individuals in the bottom 40 are less likely to have the skills that complement digital technologies






#### Digital skills decline rapidly with age

Especially among people with lower educational attainment.



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
#### Labor markets are becoming more polarized



#### With middle-skill jobs disappearing.

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
### Less and less workers have a full time and permanent salaried job in many countries

The labor share of income has declined almost everywhere





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It is not just about improving internet access.


Improving the business environment, having a skilled labor force and strengthening governance are also crucial to reap the digital dividends

**Complements:** Index of quality of institutions, skills and regulations.

**Technology:** Digital adoption index - businesses, people and governments.

# Countries need to work on trade infrastructure and reducing trade barriers

Country Groupings	Policy Priorities
Emerging	<ul> <li>Improve logistics Infrastructure</li> <li>Develop online payment systems</li> </ul>
Transitioning	<ul><li>Enhance trade facilitation measures</li><li>Improve competition</li></ul>
Transforming	<ul> <li>Reduce trade barriers in partner countries (nontariff measures, services restrictions)</li> </ul>



## Improving skills and regulations are crucial to make the most out of online work



Country Groupings	Policy Priorities
Emerging	<ul><li>Build foundational skills</li><li>Improve Internet access</li></ul>
Transitioning	<ul><li>Reduce barriers to formal work</li><li>Promote active aging</li></ul>
Transforming	<ul> <li>Reduce the number of inefficient occupational regulations</li> <li>Update labor market regulations</li> <li>Improve data collection efforts</li> </ul>



### Reaping Digital Dividends: Toward a new Renaissance?



- The Internet has unleashed a new process of "creative destruction"
