Changing face?

- Commodity boom, since 2002...to...
- Role of commodity trade in economic growth & poverty reduction, *But note challenges*....
- Price volatility, development gains; Diversification/GVCs.

New consensus?

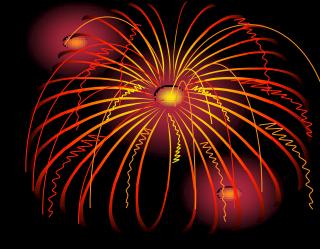
- Deal with challenges of commodity production, trade and development;
- Tap development gains from commodity booms: move up GVCs, Meet MDGs, etc.

Policy responses (1)

A. Commodity producing countries

- Address high price volatility & mitigate impacton incomes: *Safety nets*, *Risk mgt tools*;
- **Diversify Economy:** Value addition for sustained economic growth, development & poverty reduction;
- Improve transparency & accountability;
- Increase access to finance for commodity development;

Policy responses (2)



B. Commodity-importing countries

- BoP problems (DC food import bill increased by 25% to \$356bn (2007-08), almost equal to net ODA receipts);
- Food insecurity (Globally, no. of undernourished increased from 850m (2005-07) to 910m (2008) (FAO, 2010);

C. International Community


Market failures (high & unstable prices)

- Improve efficiency of markets
- Increased dialogue between consumers (food-importers) & producers (food-exporters) to reduce & stabilize world food prices

UNCTAD's role?

- Coordination International & regional actors, international commodity bodies;
- Monitor devts & challenges in commodity markets;
- Research & develop policies to:
- Manage links between international commodity trade & national development -> poverty reduction;
- Assist producing countries to harness development gains from commodity booms;
- Address problems of commodity dependence how to manage boom and burst cycles.

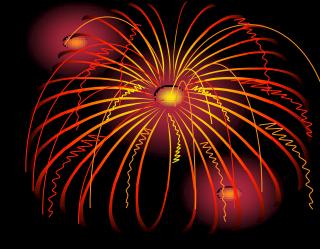
UNCTAD's role? (2)



Works through *three pillars....* A. Technical assistance, advisory services

- Develop national commodity strategies;
- Build ss-side capacity, move up GVCs/diversify
- Comply with public/private/inter'nal trade standards;
- Improve assess to commodity information & databases;
- Improve transparency & accountability, especially in extractive industries (dd-driven).


UNCTAD's role? (3)



B. Intergovernmental process

- Consensus building on (i) how to integrate commodity policies into national, regional & international development & PRSs; and (ii) Policies & instruments to resolve commodity problems (Annual sessions of the Intergovernmental Group of Experts – MYEM on commodities; IGF)
- Build multi-stakeholder partnerships new approaches to resolving commodity-related problems (GCF);
- How to access investment & finance (ODA, A4T) for commodity-based development.

UNCTAD's role? (4)

- Analytical studies commodity development & trade (sustainable strategies & policies, ss-side capacity, value addition, diversification, etc);
- Commodities and Development Report (2013:Perennial problems, new challenges and evolving perspectives)
