- •14 technical cooperation activities
 - 8 activities successfully implemented and completed;
 - 4 activities on-going;
 - 1 in preliminary discussion stage;
 - 1 waiting for funding to move forward.

- International Cocoa Organization: convene the meeting on putting into force the International Cocoa Agreement;
- Intergovernmental Forum on Mining, Mineral and Sustainable Development (IGF): convene the annual general meetings. Oct. 20-24 2014;
- Expand the impact of technical cooperation activities across borders: the UNCTAD Iron Ore Market Report translated into Chinese and distributed to China Iron and Steel Association members.

- Mexico's Agriculture Development: Perspectives and Outlook:
 - at the request from Mexico's Ministry of Agriculture,
 Livestock, Rural Development, Fisheries and Food (SAGARPA);
 - worked with DITC and prepared the study;
 - addressed the issue of Mexican agriculture development and policy with an integrated, holistic approach.



Funding

- Some of our technical activities are extra-budgetary events
 - Global Commodities Forum (GCF): previous contributions include Common Funds for Commodities, Switzerland, France, China, ACE-Group, GazNat and Afrexim Bank.
- Challenges of seeking steady and sufficient funding to continue extra-budgetary technical cooperation activities.
- Support needed so that we can respond to urgent requests for important projects in the area of commodities and development.
