



TRADE AND INNOVATION IN SMALL STATES

 - Open, trading economies
 - Limited employment opportunities so economic emigration
- Small production units so
 - Limitations on economies of scale
- Small contribution to global trade
 - Multilateral rules can't be enforcement (uncertainty)
