

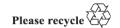

2. A report on UNCTAD's activities in support of Africa is prepared every year and presented to an executive session of the Trade and Development Board. The report provides an overview of research and analysis being undertaken by UNCTAD with regard to African development, as well as a summary of specific activities, including advisory services and technical cooperation, in each sector that falls under UNCTAD's mandate. This report complements and updates the information in document TD/B/EX(55)/2, which was submitted to the fifty-fifth executive session of the Board in July 2012. Under this agenda item, a panel will be convened on "Strengthening linkages between domestic and foreign direct investment in Africa". An interactive discussion will follow.

Item 4

Designation of non-governmental organizations and intergovernmental bodies for the purposes of rules 76 and 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board

- 7. At present, there are 209 non-governmental organizations in status with UNCTAD: 122 in the general category and 87 in the special category; and 113 intergovernmental bodies in status with UNCTAD. Lists of these organizations are contained in documents TD/B/NGO/LIST/14 and TD/B/IGO/LIST/9.
- 8. In accordance with rules 76 and 77 of the rules of procedure of the Trade and Development Board, the Board will be invited to consider three applications for inclusion in the general category of non-governmental organizations and one application for inclusion in the general category of intergovernmental bodies. Applications for observer status are to be considered from the following non-governmental organizations: Business Development Center, Iniciativa Cultural and Palestinian NGO Network. The intergovernmental body application to be considered is from the Eurasian Economic Commission.
