The negative amounts in the 2014 expenditures column pertain to the adjustments of prior year accounts and/or savings on the liquidation of the prior year's obligations.

Total income 2011–2014 is defined as contributions received within that period. In the case of projects financed by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), total incomes equal total expenditures.

Allotment is defined as funding of budget for the year.
