# INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN SERVICES 2019 QUARTER 1


World services exports remained at the level of the previous year in the first quarter of 2019 (measured in current United States dollars, year-on-year). The most recent estimates point to a slight downturn in transport and travel exports since the beginning of the year, offset by an increase in international trade of other\* services. In general, the growth observed over 2018 has receded.

**Figure 1. Global services exports growth rate** (Percentage, y-o-y, current US\$)



### **Regional developments**




Figure 2. Growth rate of total services exports by region, Q1 2019 (Percentage, y-o-y, current US\$)



On the regional level, Europe registered a decline in services exports (-2.1%). Asia and Oceania - the growth leaders - recorded an increase (+3%), mainly owing to exports of other\* services (+4.8%). The figures from Latin America and the Caribbean revealed a considerable weakening (-4.3%) of other\* services trade. While the trade in transport dropped overall in the first quarter of 2019, Latin America and the Caribbean witnessed a rise of exports in that category (+2%).

They are further comprised of construction, personal, cultural and recreational services, and government goods and services (n.i.e.). For this presentation, manufacturing, processing and repair services are also included under *other*.
