
## Trade and SDGs

  - helps accelerate pace of technological progress and adoption
  - helps spur the development of capital and financial markets
- far-reaching influence on
  - economic outcomes
  - income disparities within and across countries

## Regional and bilateral trade agreements in the MENA region






## Intra-Arab trade remains limited..



### Intra-Arab trade as a share of total trade








Share of intra-regional in total trade



### A diagnosis tool to monitor progress and inform policy making It is developed to:

- help understand challenges and opportunities
- identify binding constraints to regional integration
- monitor implementation of agreements and evaluate implications
- measure progress against comparator countries and regions (the EU, ASEAN, and some key external partners)


