



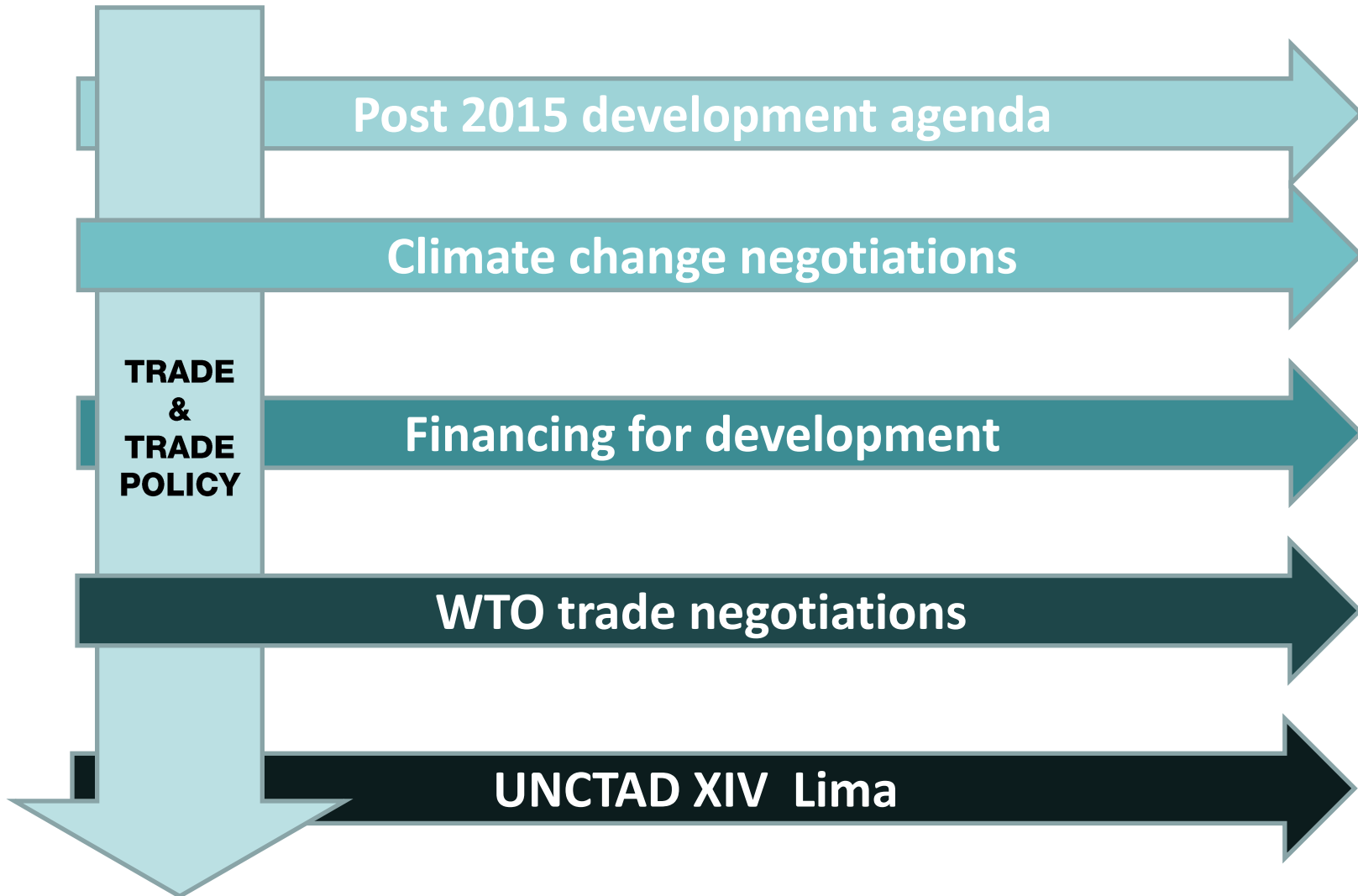

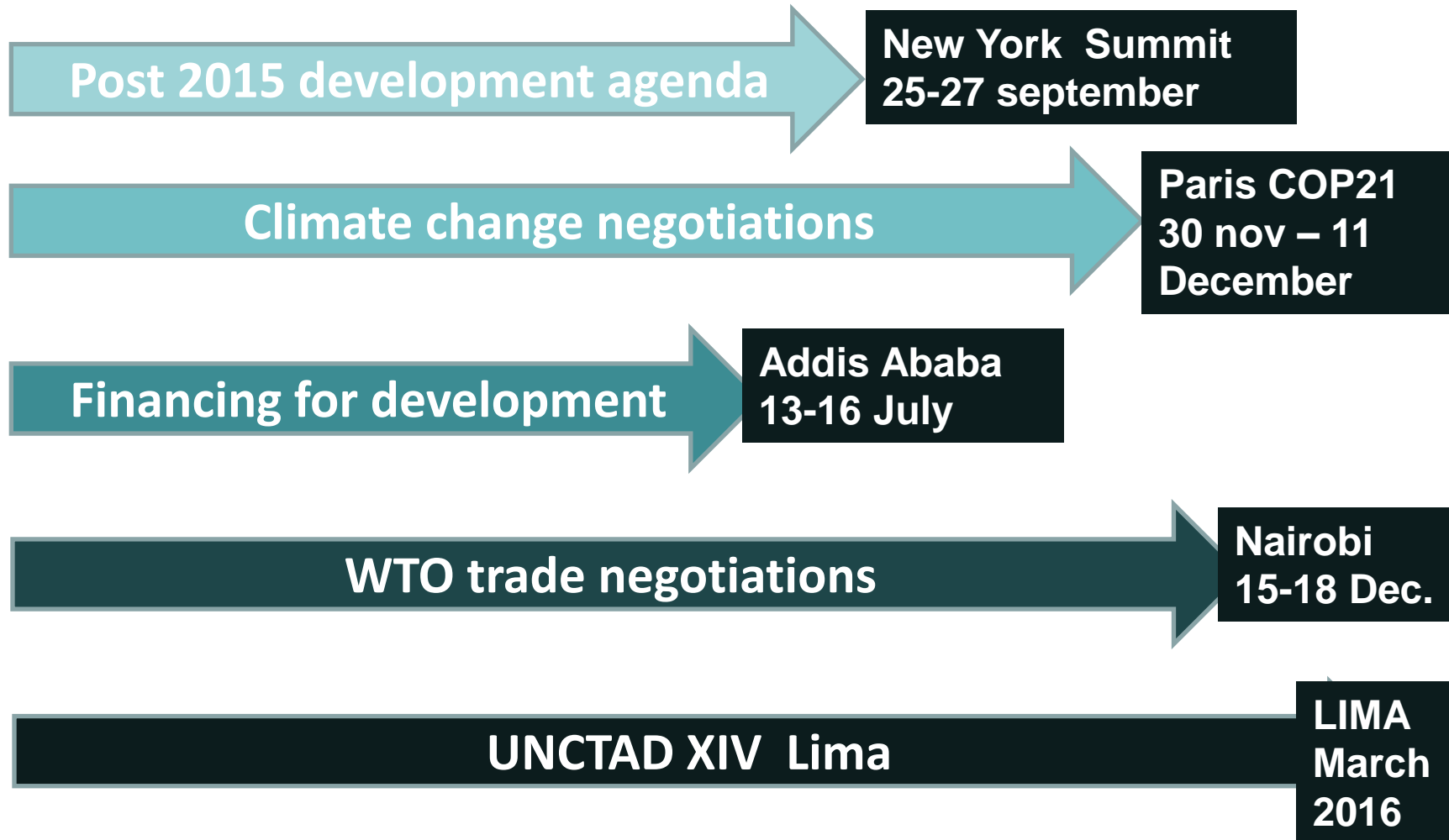


Five parallel multilateral processes

IMPLEMENTATION



Main **OUTPUTS** so far:

- the Open Working Group proposed **17 specific goals with 169 associated targets**
- **The UN SG Synthesis Report** The road to dignity by 2030: ending poverty, transforming all lives and protecting the planet
- The High-level Panel of Eminent Persons on the Post-2015 Development Agenda called for **five “transformative shifts”**
- The Intergovernmental Committee of Experts on Sustainable Development Financing proposed a basket of more than **100 options for policymakers**, together with recommendations for a global
- The Sustainable Development Solutions Network recommended the adoption of **a science-based and action-oriented agenda**, integrating four interdependent dimensions of sustainable development.
- **“A World That Counts”** by Independent Expert Advisory Group on the Data Revolution for Sustainable Development

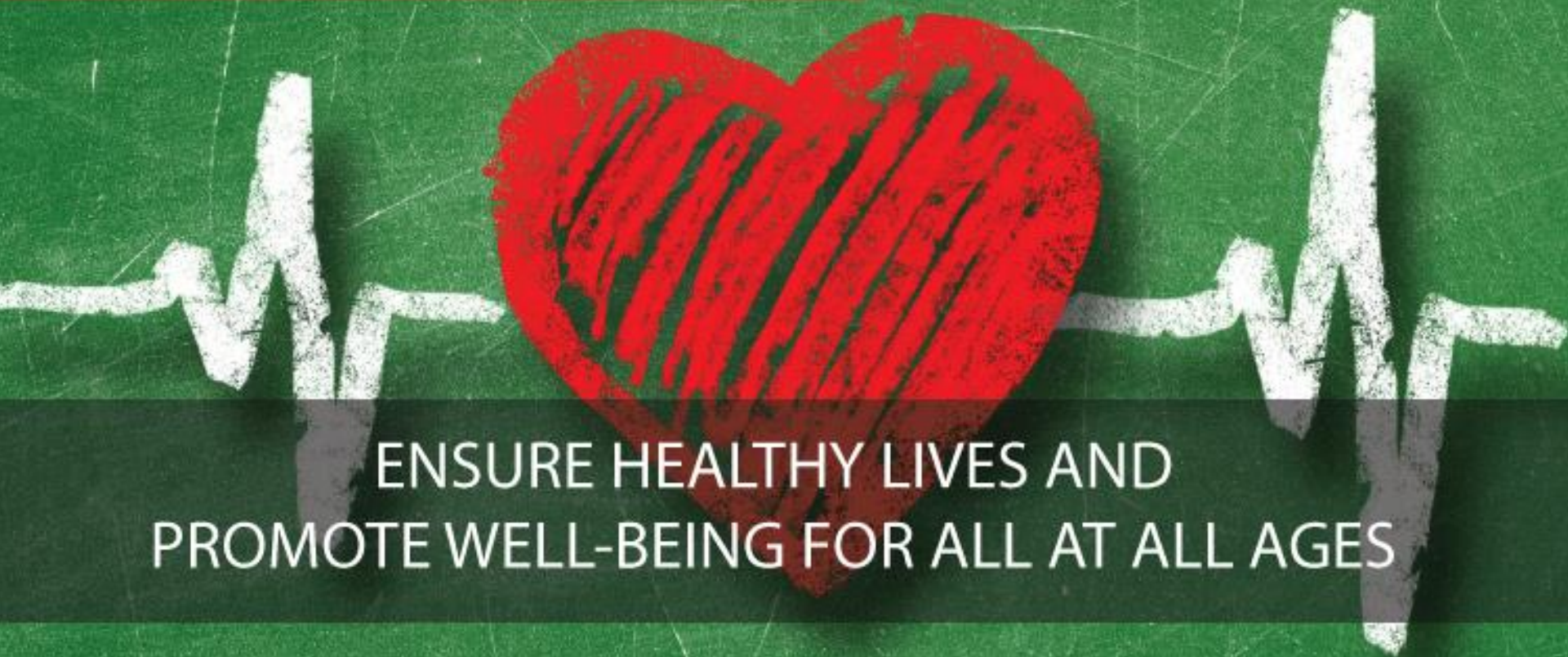

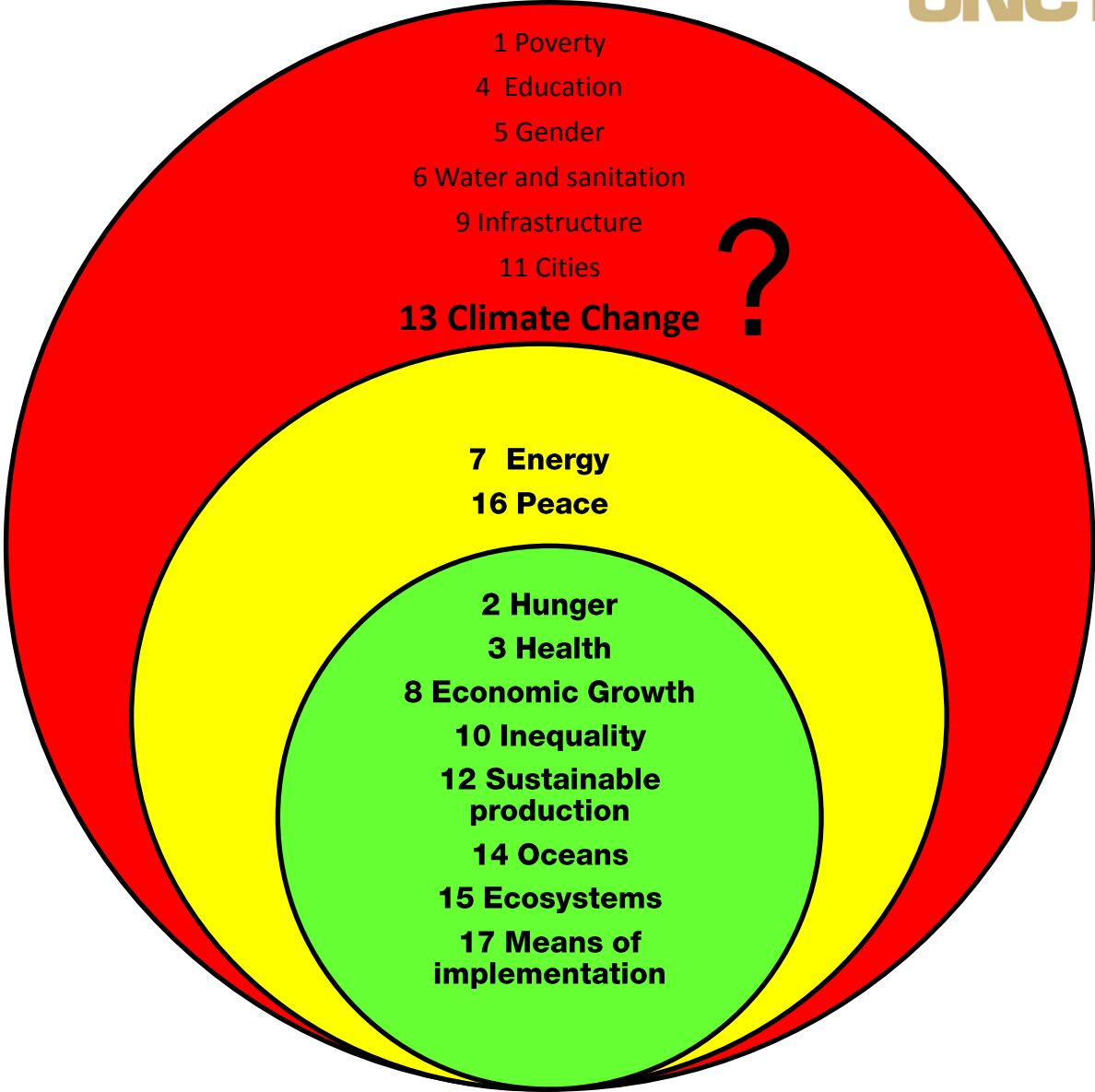
