(b) Designation of intergovernmental organizations for the purpose of rule 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board

(c) Designation of non-governmental organizations for the purposes of rule 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board

(d) Review of the calendar of meetings

(e) Membership of the Working Party for 2013

The Board approved the membership of the Working Party for 2013 as follows: Albania, Algeria, Belarus, China, Côte d'Ivoire, El Salvador, Germany, Islamic Republic of Iran, Lesotho, Mexico, Nepal, Peru, Russian Federation, Switzerland, United States of America and Viet Nam.

It was noted that three nominations still had to be received from Group B.

The Board took note of the list of States as contained in document TD/B/Inf.222.

(g) Administrative and financial implications of the actions of the Board
