## Trade and Development Board Fifty-fifth executive session

Geneva, 3–5 July 2012

The fifty-fifth executive session of the Trade and Development Board will be held on 3–5 July 2012. The session will open on Tuesday, 3 July, at 10 a.m. in Room XXVI of the Palais des Nations, Geneva.

The Security Service is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Because of the security measures in force, participants are strongly advised to arrive before 9 a.m. in order to complete entry procedures in good time and proceed to the meeting in the E-Building of the Palais. Participants are requested to carry a passport or similar national identity card with them. Taxis are not allowed to enter the grounds of the Palais des Nations; visitors will therefore be dropped off at the requested entrance gates. Furthermore, luggage may not be brought into the buildings unless the Security Service gives special clearance.
