Motivation for its establishment: The main motivations were to set up new regulations and decisions for national economic development as well as having resources to actively participate in different projects as stated below:

The Ministry of Science and Technology collaborated with the United Nations Centre for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business (UNCEFACT) and Asia Pacific Council for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business (AFACT) in 2000;

The Ministry of Science and Technology and the Ministry of Transport participated in the MultiTransport humain capacities building in 2001-2003;

The State Agency on Management Quality requested support to establish the Information and Communication Technology Standards for Process, Data Elements and Documentation in Commerce, Transport, Industry and Administration in collaboration with other Ministries. This initiative aimed to develop national trade facilitation standards in particular the UNCEFACT standards-2004:

The TCVN154 assisted the Ministry of Trade in elaborating the new e-commerce regulation, in 2006:

Ministries and the TCVN154 developed a pilot project following standards, namely Mid-Term Evaluation of the European Technical Assistance Programme for Vietnam 2 (ETV2), EU project and Metadata economics building 2008-2009.
