Institutional Framework

Degree of institutionalisation:

Type of organisation (ad hoc group, legal entity/organisation, etc): FITPRO has been set up as separate department of the Economic Chamber of the Czech Republic.

Scope/mandate: Advisory board for State Administrative and entrepreneurs.

Terms of reference: The Decree of the Ministry of International Trade, adopted in 1979, and the Decree of Ministry of Trade and Industry. According to these regulations, FITPRO seeks to create the conditions for and assist the introduction and development of effective methods in the technology of international (and domestic) trade in the Czech Republic, including electronic data interchange using the United Nations rules for Elec-tronic Data Interchange for Administration, Commerce and Transport (UN/EDIFACT) and other standards.

These methods include:

the use of internationally standardised documents in international trade;

the use of internationally standardised codes in commercial dealings e.g. codes for countries, currencies, measurement units, and INCOTERMS abbreviations;

the use of standardised data elements in trade documents;

the use of internationally introduced methods and procedures in accordance with the Trade Facilitation Recommendations issued by the United Nations/European Economic Commission Centre for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business: and

the use of electronic data interchange in accordance with international EDIFACT standards.
