Level of participation: The meetings are attended by representatives from:

the administration;

the non-governmental organisations; and

the companies-members of the BULPRO Council.

Meetings format: Various formats of meetings like round tables, discussions, etc.

Promotion / Communication:

Communication channels to keep stakeholders informed of TF meetings: By e-mail Interface with other working groups/committees on similar issues: By e-mail Undertake information sessions to stakeholders or general public:
