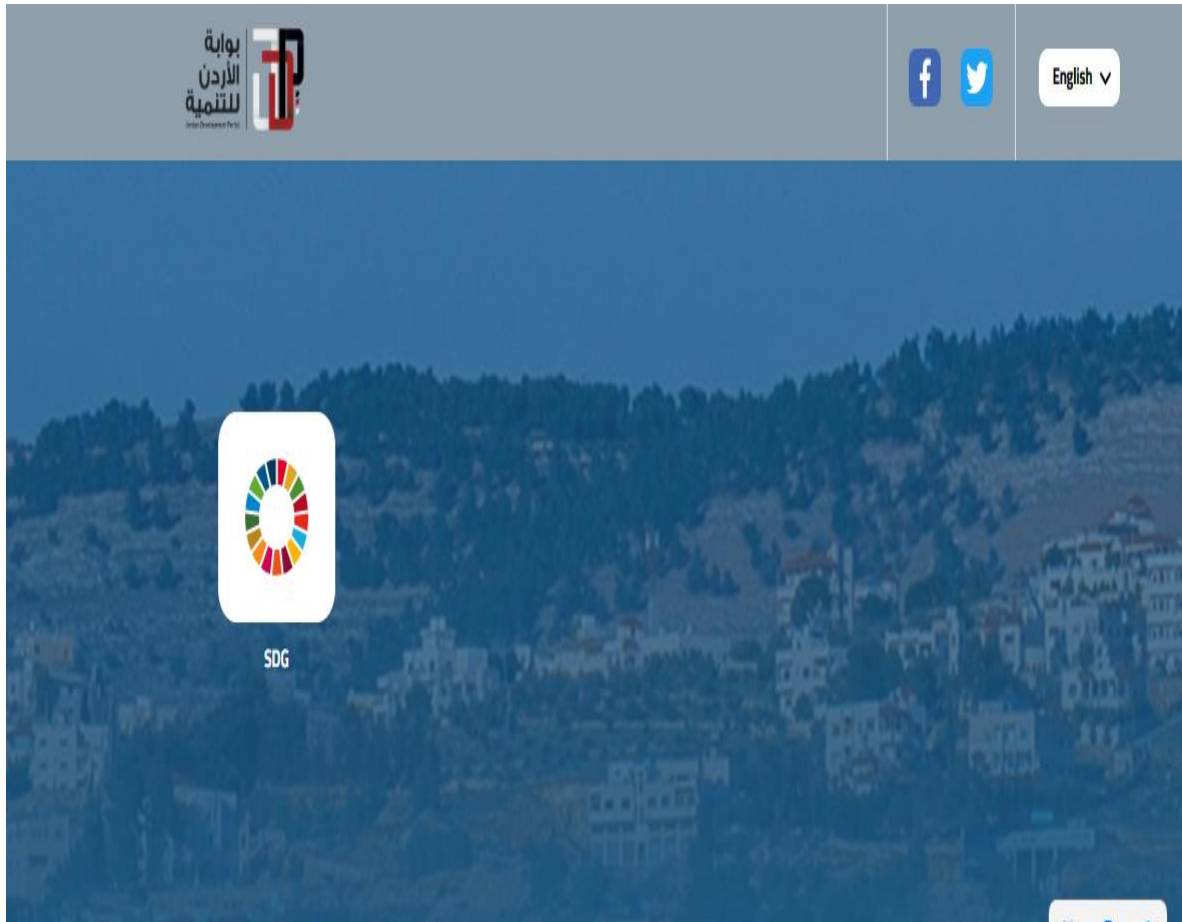

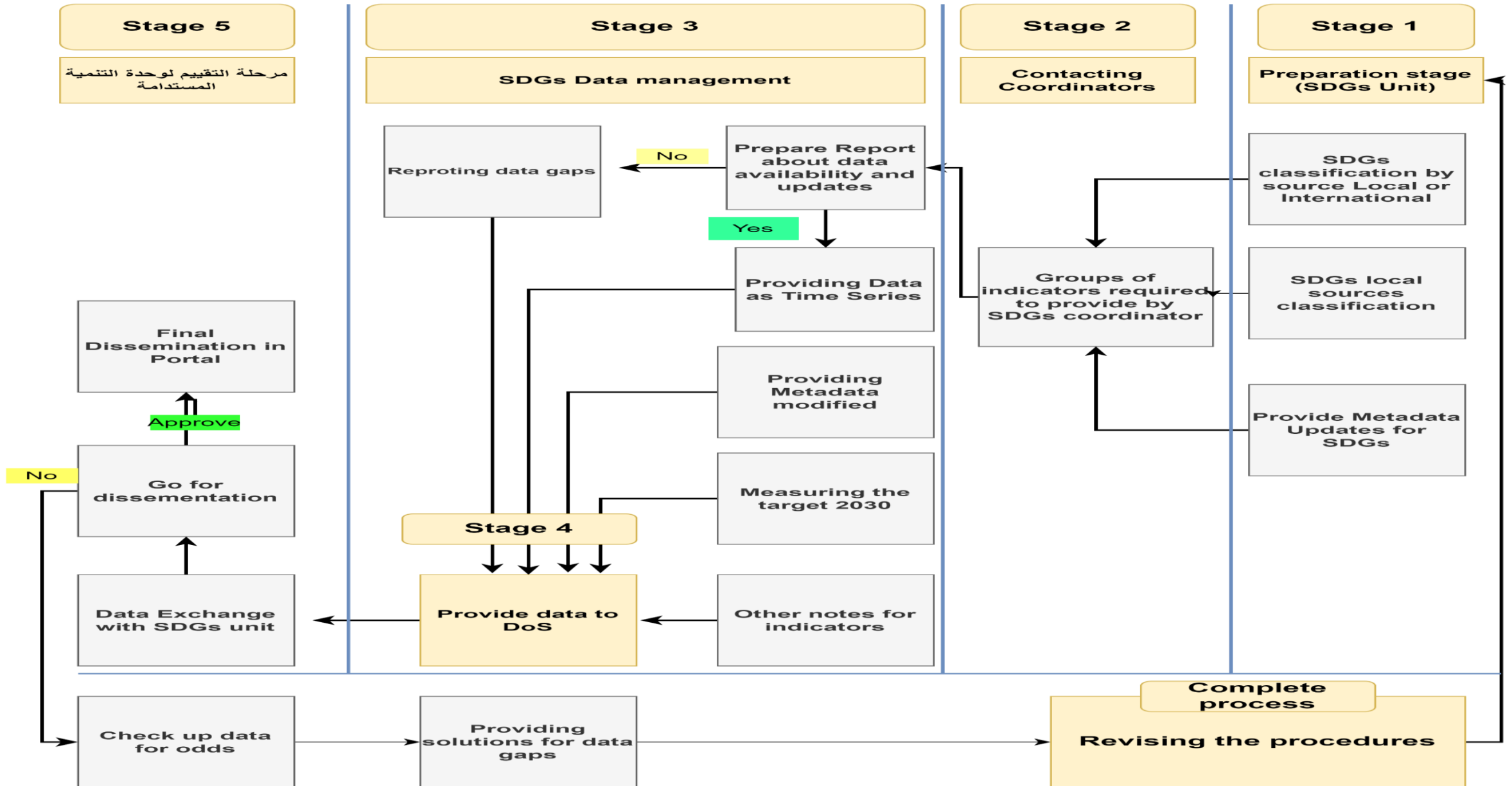

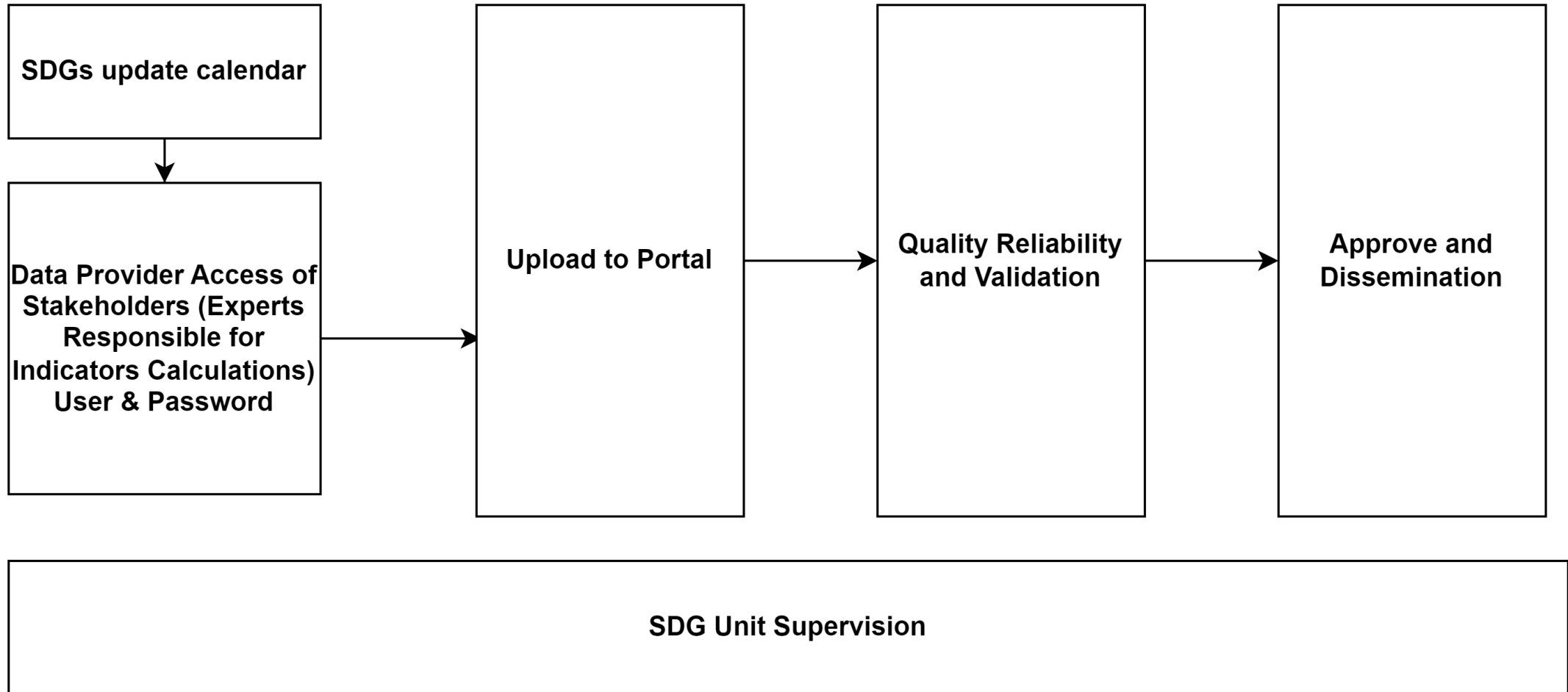

International Cooperation Mechanism

Initiatives

- The initiative of the international cooperation is made by the beneficiary governmental body.
- According to the objectives, the type of assistant will be determined.
- The assistants include two parts:
 - 1- The financial loans that drafted directly by the internal organizations to the Central Bank of Jordan under the supervision of the Ministry of Finance.
 - 2- The technical assistant which is recorded as part of the financial aids and included in the governmental financial records, but these aids are budgeted and expended international organization directly.

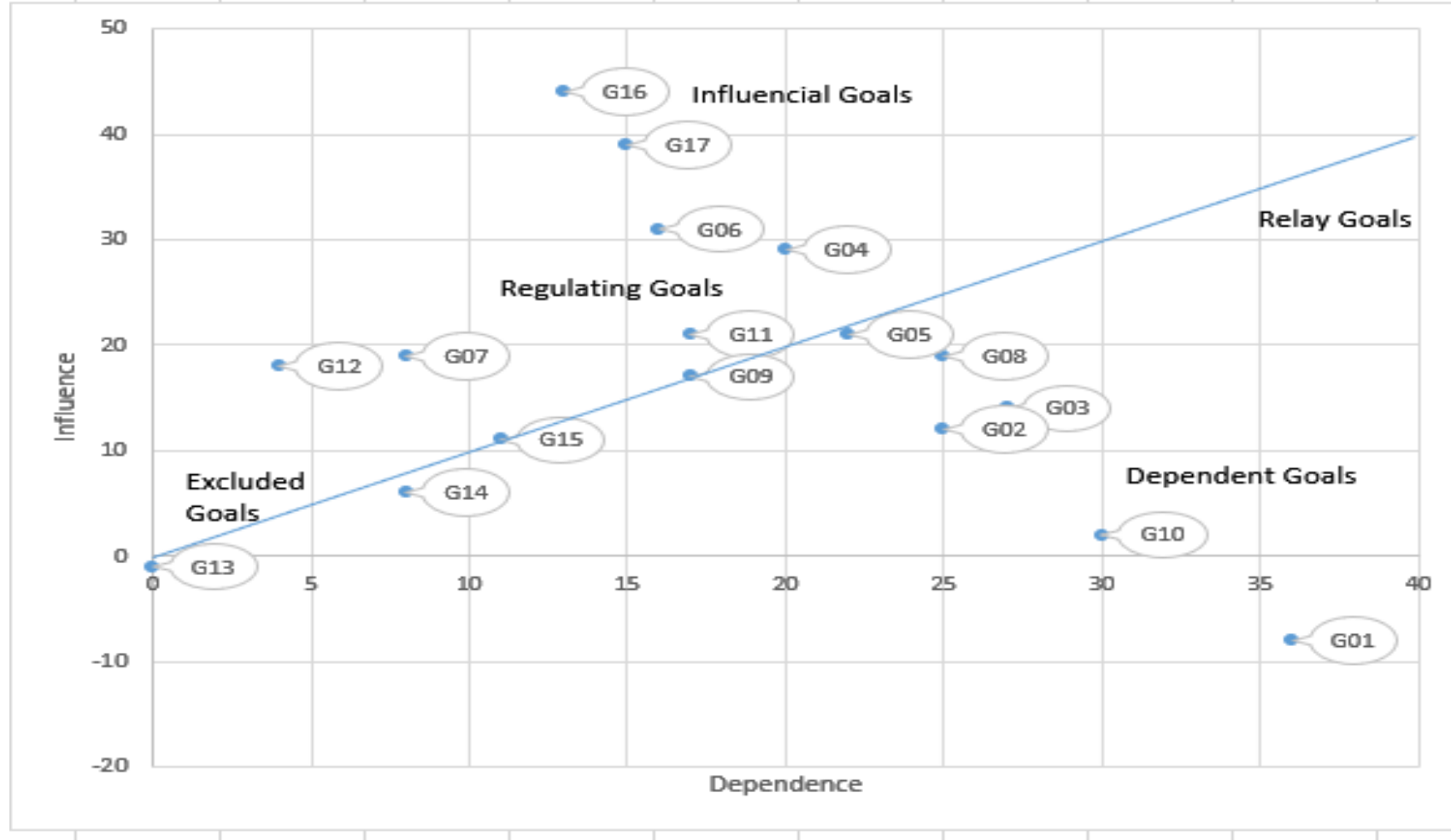
Approvals required for international aids and loans

- The cooperation with international bodies should be approved by the Ministry of Planning and International Cooperation (MoPIC) with the supervision on the execution of these projects financially and technical performance.
- The loans and aids should be approved by the cabinet before the execution process.
- The Ministry of Finance should approve any cooperation contracts before the execution.
- The international agreements are signed and approved by the MoPIC for the benefit of the governmental body made the initiative.

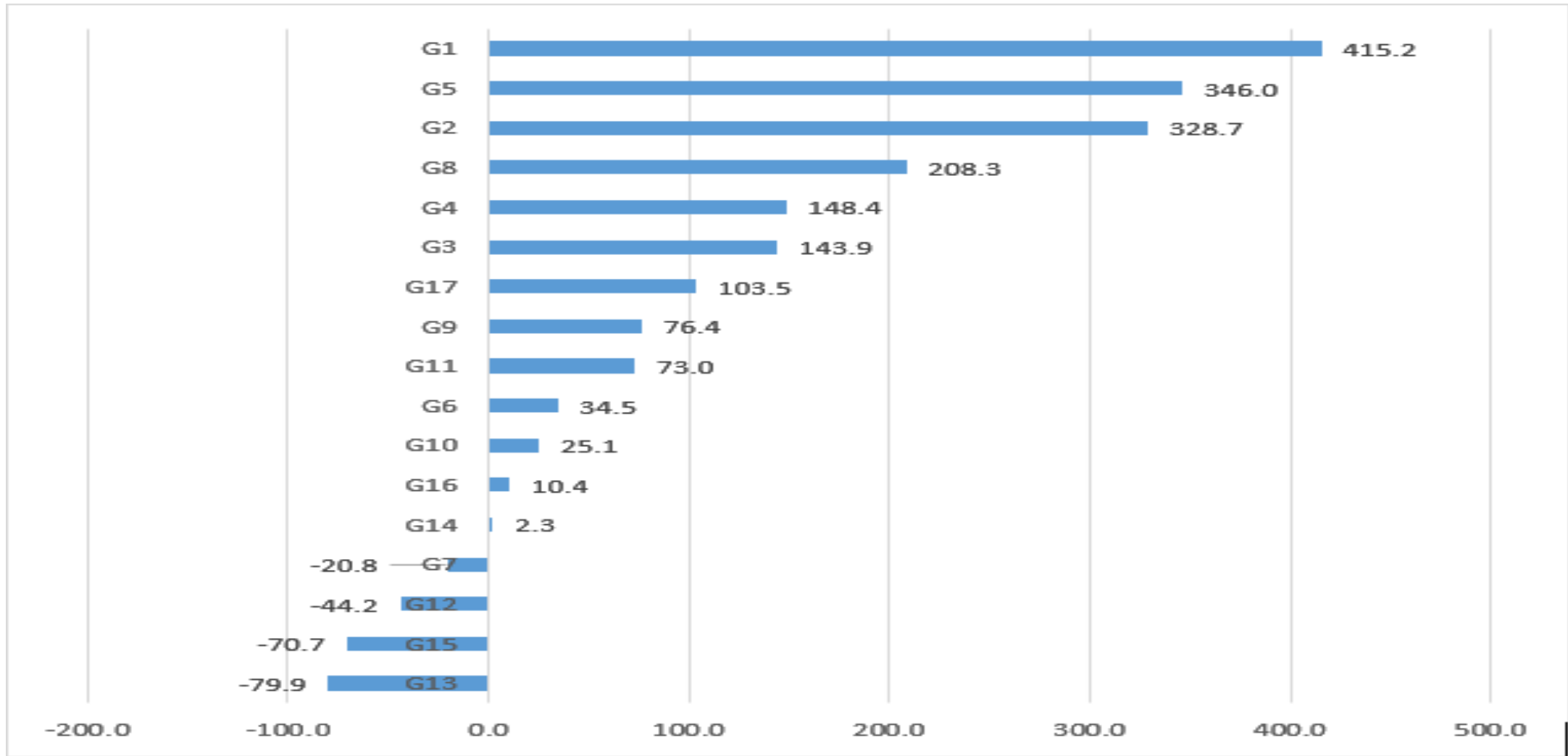
International cooperation recording

- The government established the governmental database for international cooperation. The information about the different projects are recorded according to template prepared and distributed by cabinet.
- The database established in 2022
- The data provided included the budgets of the projects, the type of assistant financial or technical, the international body provide the assistance and other related information.
- The database is updated annually and it is supervised by the Ministry of Finance.
