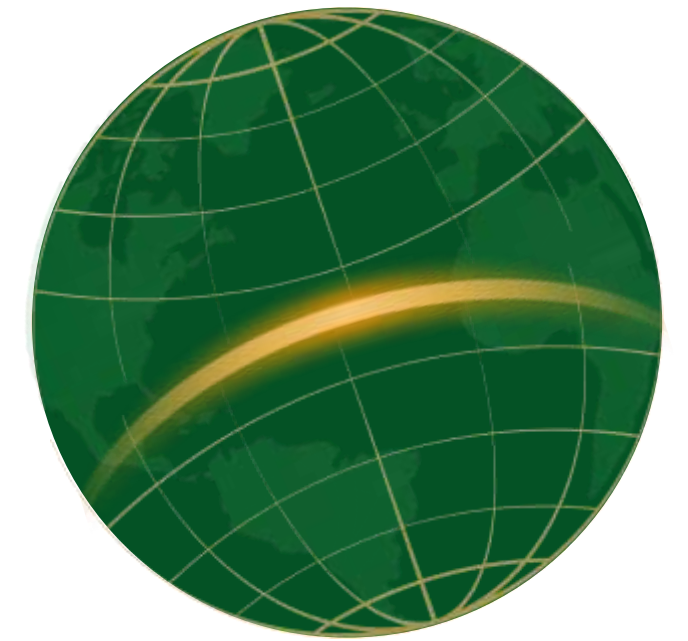

What can be analyzed, from a national perspective?

- Cooperation initiatives per Ministry/Agency;
- Spending with International Cooperation per Ministry/Agency;
- South–North International Technical Cooperation;
- Foreign nationals' hospitalizations in Brazil;
- Total spending and # of initiatives in International Cooperation per institution;
- Total spending with technical cooperation per institution;
- Total spending per first reported SDG and SDG goal;
- # of initiatives per first reported SDG and SDG goal;
- # of initiatives and total spending per economic sector;
- Total spending and # of initiatives per modality;
- Spending and # initiatives per cooperation framework;

What can be analyzed, from a national perspective?

- Breakdown of expenses by modality;
- Breakdown of expenses per selected (top contributors) institutions;
- Breakdown of spending and characteristics of the international cooperation per selected recipient countries. Ex: Education and Scholarships (types and characteristics), Funding Agencies.
- Characteristics that differ from year to year (recipient countries, scholarships, donation of food/grains, emergency assistance, compulsory contributions, technical cooperation specificities,

Methods and approaches for analysing SSC

- Brazil has no norm to enforce data sharing on International Cooperation;
- Brazilian COBRADI report is a voluntary report;
- IPEA invites all Federal and Subnational (states) Government institutions to participate;
- Institutions share their Cooperation Initiatives;
- COBRADI team analyses each Institution's report, checking sector, SDG, SDG Goal, Cooperation Framework, initiative description and title, channel, etc
- IPEA COBRADI team analyses international cooperation spending with the National Treasury System;
- Follow up with the institutions when there is divergent, missing or additional information not provided by the institution;
- COBRADI site and reports follow transparency principles

I - Identification data	Fields for basic identification of the activity being reported
◆ 1 - Reporting year	Calendar year for which data is reported.
◆ 2 - Provider partner	Unique code identifying the reporting country partner.
◆ 3 - Provider agency	Unique code identifying the agency within the provider partner that has budget responsibility and controls the activity for its own account.
◆ 4 - Provider ID number of the action reported	Unique code for identifying the action reported in the provider's internal databases.
5 - Custodian agency ID number	Unique code for identifying the custodian agency in the custodian agency database.
