Introduction

The Technology Assessment (TA) project in Seychelles on agrivoltaics for controlled-environment crop production is approaching its conclusion. The Seychelles team has successfully navigated through all the steps outlined in the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) TA Methodology, resulting in the completion of a comprehensive TA Report. This report, which analyses the role of agrivoltaics for controlled-environment crop production within the country's national development, as well as its challenges and opportunities, is accompanied by an Action Plan aimed at facilitating the widespread adoption and diffusion of biogas technology.

A crucial step in finalizing this endeavour is to validate the findings and recommendations of the TA Report, along with the proposed Action Plan. Recognising the significance of stakeholder input in this validation process, the Ministry of Investment, Entrepreneurship & Industry (MIEI), in collaboration with UNCTAD, is organizing a joint national validation workshop. This workshop is designed to provide stakeholders with a platform to offer feedback on the project outputs before they are finalised and launched.

In addition to the launch of the TA Report and Action Plan, the workshop will feature the launch of the Science, Technology and Innovation Policy (STIP) Review, an element of the TA project that helped to improve the understanding of the relevant policy and systemic challenges of the country.
