1. Participation and registration

The event “WSIS at 20: successes, failures and future expectations” led by the United Nations Commission on Science and Technology for Development (CSTD) will be held during the second day of the Internet Governance Forum 2023 on Tuesday, 10 October 2023 from 15:15 to 16:45 (JST/UTC+9). The meeting will be held in English only and there will be no interpretation. Participants will include representatives from national governments, international organizations, academia, the private sector and civil society.

2. Format of the discussions

The Chair of the CSTD will moderate this session. The head of the CSTD Secretariat will make opening remarks. After a high-level official from the Government of Japan delivers a keynote speech, discussion starters will share their views and insights. This will be followed by free-style roundtable discussions, under the moderation of the Chair of CSTD.

Remote participants can request the floor by using the hand raising function on the online platform (i.e. Zoom). Delegates and speakers participating in the meeting room can ask for the floor as usual. Each intervention will be given 3 to 4 minutes while the moderator will manage time as appropriate.
