Before Joining | Preparing for a Meeting



We are excited to have you taking part of a meeting on KUDO. Please refer to the items below to help you prepare and make the most of the presentation.



A Good Headset

- Ideally, a USB Headset.
- Avoid using earbuds type unless you are following from your phone.
- Place the microphone close to your mouth but avoid breathing into it.



Internet Connectivity

- Use Chrome or Firefox browser to connect. (Allow access to camera and microphone. Avoid using ad-blockers)
- Use a wired connection. (Preferred)
- If wired connection is not available, use high-speed Wi-Fi instead. (Ideally 20 and 5 Mbps, for download and upload respectively. 5Ghz / 802.11ac is highly recommended)

1 A Webcam

- An HD webcam is preferred to get a high quality video.
- Point the camera directly at yourself.
- When you seat in front of your computer, leave enough distance between you and the camera, so your face is entirely visible.



Professional Environment

- Choose a private and quiet room to speak from.
- Make sure the lighting in the room is adequate.
- Place yourself so that there is a blank or plain background.




From a computer
