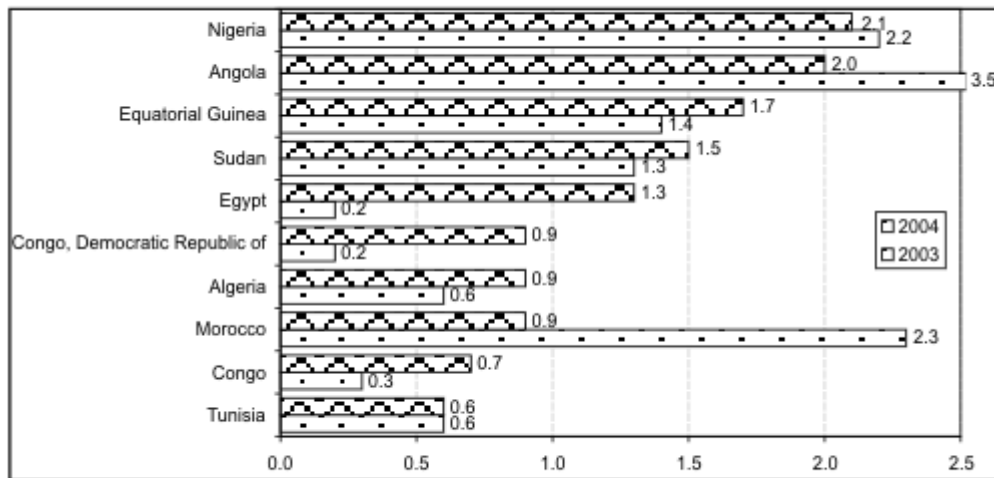

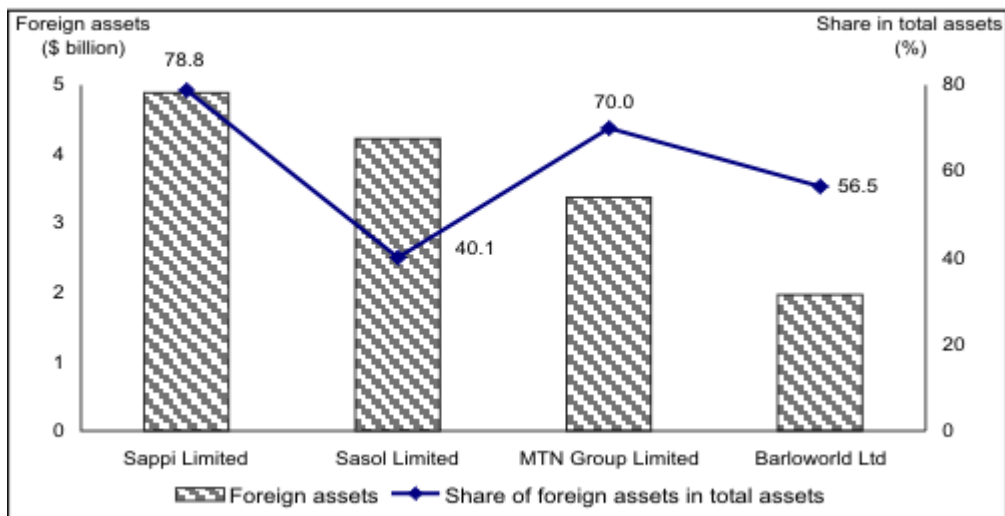
Figure 1. FDI inflows to Africa, top 10 recipients, 2003, 2004^a
