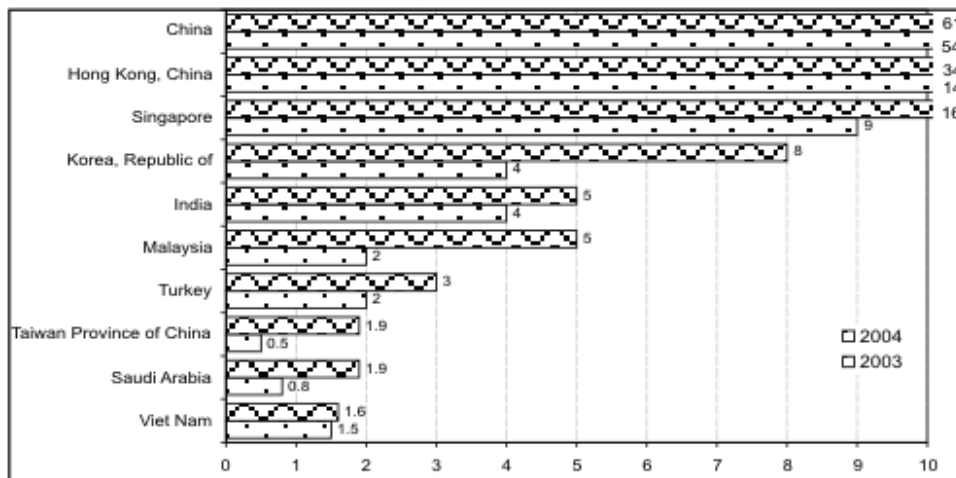

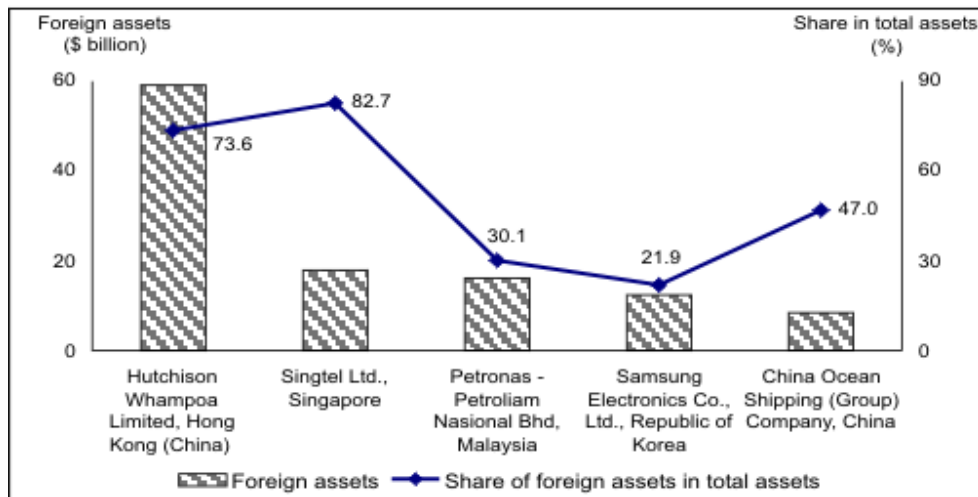
Figure 1. FDI inflows to Asia and Oceania, top 10 economies, 2003, 2004 *
