## Building port resilience against pandemics TrainForTrade online course

6-31 March 2023

The UNCTAD secretariat is pleased to announce that a Train for Trade programme (TrainForTrade) special course on building port resilience against pandemics will be held online from 6 to 31 March 2023 in English, French and Spanish.

The course combines online sessions, simulation exercises and a webinar. The aim of the course is to support port authorities and operators in facing and acting against the potential spread of infectious diseases, to keep ports safe and operational during pandemics, and to facilitate the implementation of protocols in order to ensure the health and safety of workers and cargo flow continuity.
