TrainForTrade online course Building port resilience against pandemics

19 February - 13 March 2024

The UNCTAD secretariat is pleased to announce that a Train for Trade programme (TrainForTrade) course on building port resilience against pandemics will be held online from 19 February to 13 March 2024 in English, French and Spanish.

The course combines online sessions, simulation exercises and a webinar. The aim of the course is to support port authorities and operators in facing and acting against the potential spread of infectious diseases, to help keep ports safe and operational during pandemics and to facilitate the implementation of protocols in order to ensure the health and safety of workers along with cargo flow continuity.
