

Entrepreneurship Policy Framework: 6 priority policy areas

General entrepreneurship policy

- Set up a national entrepreneurship policy
- Embed entrepreneurship into national development plans
- Establish institutions
- Set up institutional focal points

Awareness and network building

- Develop entrepreneurial culture
- Building awareness
- Role models and networks
- Develop national events that recognize entrepreneurs

Access to finance

- Expanding credit guarantees, equity financing
- Partnership with the private sector
- Non-traditional vehicles in developing countries
- Improve access to finance for targetd groups (minorities, women, youth, micro)

Education and skills

- Teach entrepreneurship skills at all levels
- Development of new curricula
- Teacher development
- Partnership with the private sector

Innovation and technology upgrading

- Promote use and diffusion of technology
- Public investment in R&D
- Providing incentives to the private sector
- Supporting linkages between research and Industry

Regulatory environment

- Reduce administrative burdens of formation and wind-up
- Improve general business environment
- Streamline and unify formalities and procedures
- Bankruptcy laws, property laws, competition policy





Policy area: Entrepreneurship Education and Skills

Key Messages for Policymakers:

- Reflect entrepreneurship education policy in national economic and social development plans, poverty reduction strategies
- Embed entrepreneurship at all levels of education (primary, secondary, higher and vocational education) and promote behavourial, experiential and innovative approaches
- Support entrepreneurship education outside formal education system.
