# Intergovernmental Group of Experts on Financing for Development Sixth session

### Geneva, 30 November to 2 December 2022

The sixth session of the Intergovernmental Group of Experts on Financing for Development will be held from 30 November to 2 December 2022 in room XVII of the Palais des Nations. The meeting will open at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, 30 November, and close at 5 p.m. on Friday, 2 December 2022 (CET). Both in-person attendance and remote participation using an online platform will be possible with interpretation in all United Nations languages. Sessions will take place between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. and between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. (CET) each day. Further information on the modalities will be sent in due course.

#### Logistics

For in-person attendance, before entering the Palais des Nations, participants are requested to collect their badges from the United Nations Security Service, at Villa Les Feuillantines, 13 Avenue de la Paix. The Security Service is open from 8 a.m. to 4.45 p.m. Because of the security measures in force, participants are strongly advised to arrive before 9 a.m. to complete entry procedures in good time and proceed to the meeting in Building E of the Palais through the Peace Gate bis. Participants are requested to carry a passport or similar national identity card with them. Taxis are not allowed to enter the grounds of the Palais des Nations. Visitors should therefore be dropped off at the indicated entrance gates. Furthermore, luggage may not be brought into the buildings unless the Security Service gives special clearance.
