Development Priorities for an NCQG fit to developing countries' needs

8 September 2024

This workshop will explore key elements of an NCQG for climate finance that can address the real needs of developing countries. Discussions will be grounded in the context in which the NCQG will be established, namely ongoing debates around reform of the global financial architecture to provide sufficient fiscal space for every country to achieve climate and development goals. The workshop will include considerations on:

- The links between climate, finance and economic development challenges
- Priority considerations to ensure improved quality of climate financing delivered via the NCQG
- Plausible financing scenarios to inform ongoing negotiations on the quantum of the NCQG for climate finance in 2025.
