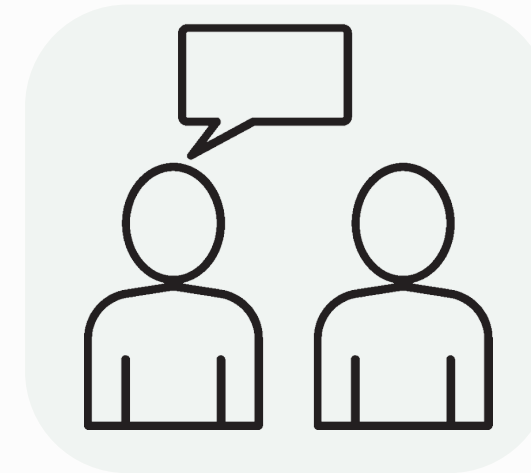

# Objectives

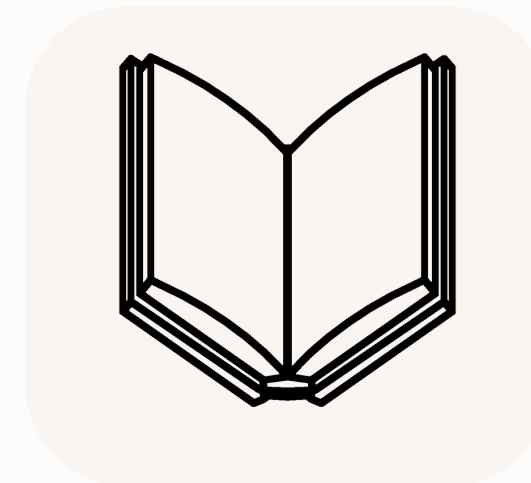
Collect and analyze data	The COBRADI study aims to gather comprehensive data on Brazil's cooperation with other countries, specifically focusing on advancing Sustainable Development Goals and 2030 Agenda.
Examine spending and implementation	The research seeks to identify how much Brazil spends and how the country implements international cooperation initiatives, providing insights into the allocation and effectiveness of resources.
Contribute to international cooperation metrics	COBRADI's data is used to build annual submissions to the South-South cooperation for development within the UNCTAD and other international cooperation metrics.

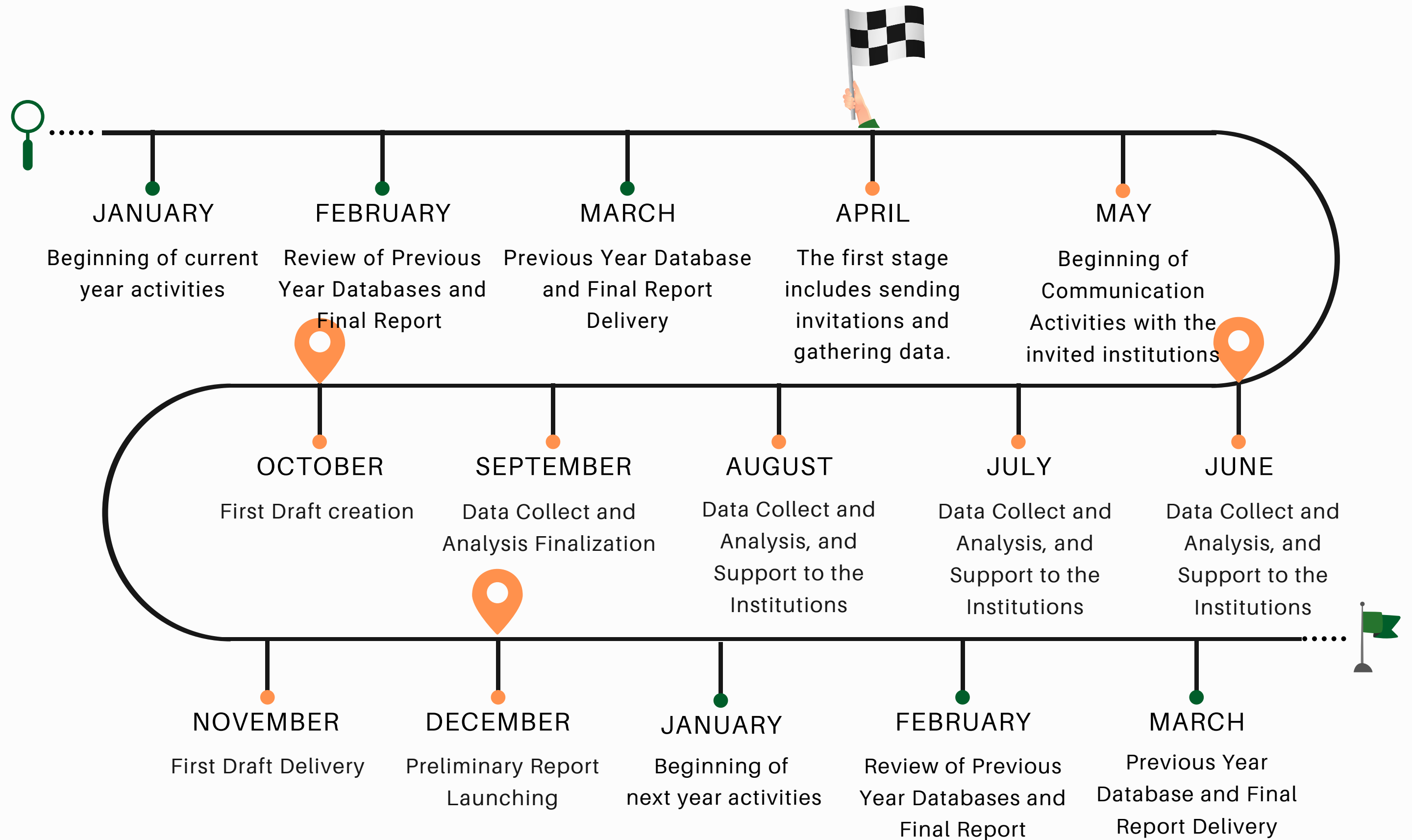

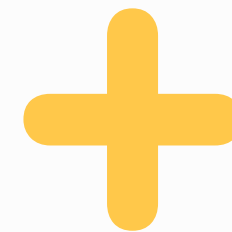

# Important notes



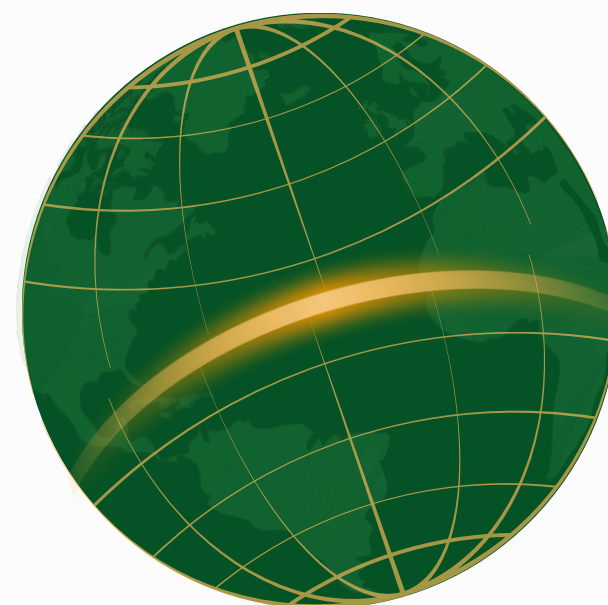
- Strong follow up strategy
- Different approaches to different public
- Research team available to doubts and concerns (email, phone, meetings)
- Different tools and instruments to guide institutions
- Research has an informational and educational role, promoting awareness and knowledge sharing culture



# Lessons learned

- Subnational levels may need more assistance
- List of institution must be updated for every research cycle
- Heterogeneity of institutions' maturity on the subject
- Political cycles (elections) impact the research
- Technology may be tricky. The simpler the better
