
































Contribution of TOSSD in the data submission for SDG indicator 17.3.1

Exclusions from TOSSD data submission

Exclusion of data from SSC providers: Azerbaijan, Brazil, Chile, Costa Rica, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Kuwait, Mexico, Nigeria, Peru, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Thailand, Türkiye, United Arab Emirates

Exclusions mentioned in the metadata of 17.3.1 e.g. nongrant instruments other than loans, debt relief etc.



Keeping the OECD – UNCTAD systems interoperable for an efficient joint data submission to SDG indicator 17.3.1.



UNCTAD and OECD as co-custodians need to coordinate to ensure there is no overlaps in global reporting for this indicator: for a given multilateral organisation reporting its outflows (4 and 5 above), inflows (2 and 3) should not be included to avoid double counting.
