WHAT IS OCID?

The Observatory of International Development Cooperation (OCID, in Portuguese) is a Brazilian initiative designed by the Brazilian Cooperation Agency of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (ABC/MRE) in partnership with the Brazilian Institute of Information in Science and Technology (IBICT).



WHAT ARE ITS FUNCTIONALITIES?

It is a platform available in 4 languages (Spanish, French, English and Portuguese) with integrated information on International Development Cooperation practices that can be accessed by public officials, academia and society in general. OCID allows cumulative inclusion of information based on criteria designed to ensure standardization in its consultation modules: relevant actors, library, data sources, events and terminology.



WHO IS ITS TARGET AUDIENCE?

OCID consolidates a collection that was previously dispersed on the web, offering a search and retrieval point for documents, links and data on the subject.

It was developed to publish, indicate and preserve data and documents, in a multilingual, interoperable and easy-to-use environment.

It is aimed at different audiences, from technical and political professionals, policy makers, students, researchers and other strategic actors for international development cooperation.

HOW IS IT STRUCTURED?

LIBRARY: It allows access to an assortment of international and national documents regarding international cooperation or links to other sites where they can be accessed. These documents include international agreements; regional and multilateral documents; technical documents; manuals; handbooks; academic texts; etc.

DATA: Indicates data platforms and official statistics from national governments and international organizations.

EVENTS: Promotes seminars, exhibitions, workshops and thematic workshops.

TERMINOLOGY: Indicates terms or conceptual issues on International Development Cooperation.

CONTENT CURATION

ABC curates the OCID content and counts on the voluntary collaboration of students, researchers and stakeholders interested in international development cooperation to suggest documents.
