
What is Orange Corners?

Orange Corners support young entrepreneurs to turn innovative ideas into sustainable businesses through training, mentorship, networks, access to finance, ecosystem support and more.






Orange Corners: Timeline





Orange Corners: Network






Orange Corners: Ecosystem Approach

Dimension 1: OC programme

- Orange Corners Incubation and Acceleration programme
 - Training, finance, mentorship, network
 - 2 Cohorts per year
 - 15-25 Startups per cohort
 - 12 Masterclasses
- Alumni community
 - Community of Practice (CoP)
 - Networking and mutual learning
 - Exchanging ideas and experiences
 - Improve quality of the OC programmes



Mariam Lawani: Greenhill Recycling OC Nigeria



Households exchange recyclable materials for Green Points, in turn they can buy groceries, utility bills, and school supplies



Recycled materials are sold to manufacturers



90 employees and 8,500 individuals have earned cash through recycling, 400,000 tons of plastic waste collected



Greenhill Recycling aims to raise \$500,000 to build a factory with a 900-ton daily processing capacity

CoP Regenerative and Circular Economy



Topic chosen through surveys

What was done?



- 1. Workshop on regenerative and circular economy & entrepreneurship
- 2. Examples of regenerative and circular business models with practical tools and frameworks
- 3. Spreading awareness and connecting to relevant organizations, such as the Dutch CIRCO and New Economy



Dimension 2: OCIF

- Orange Corners Innovation Fund (OCIF)
- Track I: Provides Grants and Technical Assistance alongside OC incubation programme
 - Is granted as a prototype voucher and monthly allowance
 - Up to max. €5,000 per entrepreneur
- Track II: 3-5 entrepreneurs are selected at the end of each cohort
 - Access per entrepreneur to max. €50,000 startup seed funding*
 - Partly a grant and partly a loan
 - Offers business development support for a period of 12 – 18 months

Digital innovation & sustainable farming practices



OCIF 2023 – 40.000 euro subsidy with 10.000 euro loan in Track II. Turnover 2024 25.820 euros



Investments used for procurement of operational equipment and working capital





Systemic approach with inclusive policymaking and digital innovation




Guarantee Fund managed by *Fonds de Garantie de l'Entrepreneuriat au Congo (FOGEC),* with digitalization of application process


