IFFS MEASUREMENT-POLICY/PRACTICE LINKAGES

- Post-Measurement means from measurement to:
- Creating new Tools and improving existing ones to assist Customs, FIC, regulators and law investigators/enforcement agencies (Real-Time and risks Assessment/monitoring
- 2. Creating and sustaining Public awareness and support
- 3. Building Legislative Awareness and support(support the Legislators Against IFFS and corruption)
- 4. Advocating Policy change or new ones
- 5. Existing Law/regulations reforms or new ones
- 6. Enforcement enhancement of existing laws and regulations



IFFS IN GHANA-Work Plan

- Validate Ghana's Trade mis-invoicing based on PCM and PFM Methods from 2000-2012- inward and outward IFFs amounted to US\$8,4 billion for USA and EU only
- Estimate IFFs in Imports/exports for the period-2013-2022
- Consider Filling in gaps in Estimates for 2000-to 2012 for Asia, Africa, etc.
- Consider a 3rd Method for estimating IFFs
- Develop Legislative Engagement strategy/plan
- Develop Public Engagement Strategy and plan
- Support Inter-Agency coordination and collaboration on IFFs
- Develop a Media engagement strategy and plan



SUPPORT REQUIRED

- Refresher Training for old and new members of the TWP
- Training on data science-AI, Big Data, Statistical, etc.
- Data collection from Ghana's trade partners
- Data on Tax returns, investments and production
- Money for periodic meetings of the TWP
- Money for media, Legislative and public engagement
- Money for the work of the estimating team compiling the estimates
- Permanent Computer servers to build and maintain international trade data, investment, tax returns, production data
