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


#### Is globalization in retreat?

#### Trade may be reconfiguring along geopolitical lines


#### **Geographic distance travelled** by trade


#### "Geopolitical distance" travelled by trade

0-10 scale




#### **Import concentration**

Percent change, 2017-23




#### Latin America's trading ties have shifted over time

Largest extra-regional trading partner




#### Caribbean trade remains more aligned to the US and Europe


Largest extra-regional trading partner




#### Trade patterns vary across countries



#### Caribbean imports are highly concentrated




#### High concentration plays out across sectors, especially in energy



#### Investment may be shifting, too


Patterns in announced cross-border greenfield investment, 2015-2023 through October




#### A future path of fragmentation would look different from a path of diversification – there are trade-offs

Evolution of goods trade indicators, 2022-35, across illustrations






#### Goods import concentration, HHI

#### **Economic integration of Caricom with other regions**

- Ease of doing business Single window, data transparency
- Regulatory alignment Tariffs, WTO trade facilitation, declaration on good regulatory practices, phytosanitary, etc.
- Harmonization on tax and banking practices for investment attraction
- Infrastructure Energy, communication, transport and logistics
- Talent attraction students, skilled workers and entrepreneurs



#### **Global integration** through services

- Requires reliable and resilient energy and communications infrastructure
- Quality of life to attract businesses and talent: safety, health, education, culture
- Ease of travel flights, accommodations, visas, citizenship
