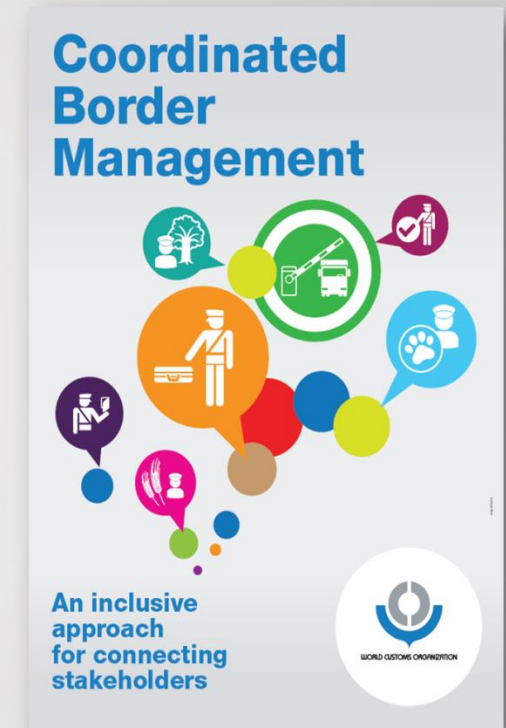
- modern supply chain security standards

- closer partnership between Customs and business



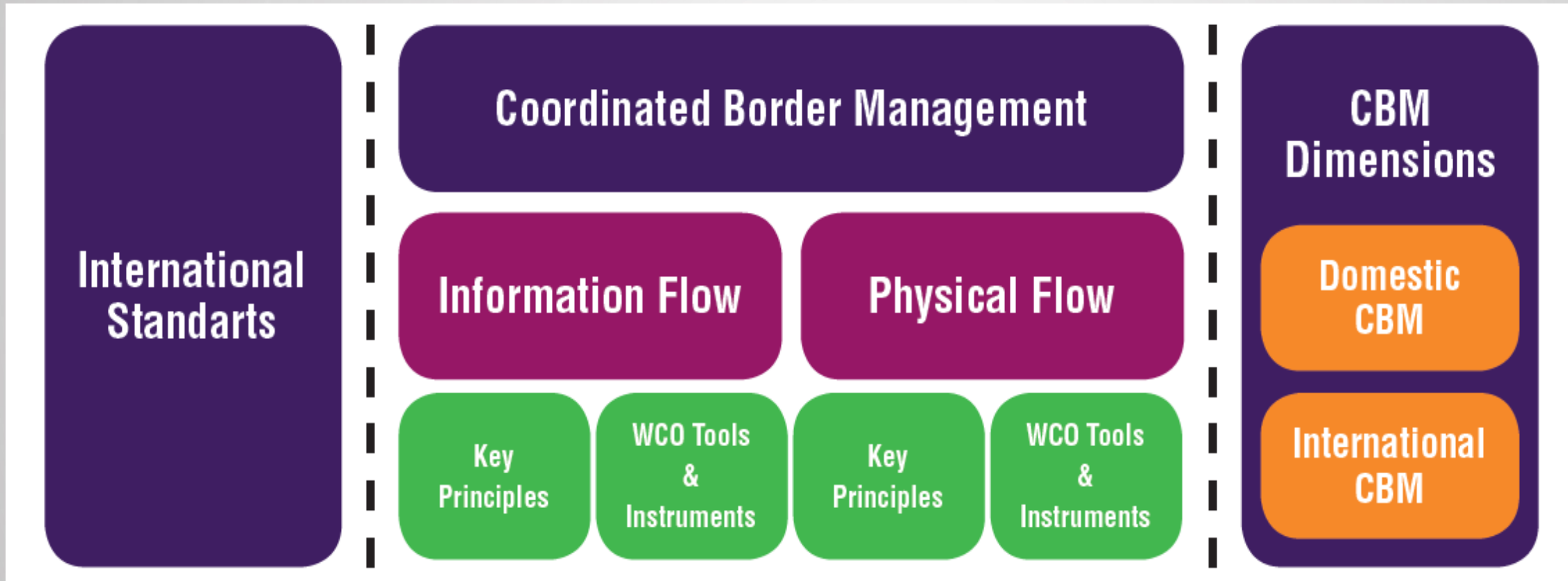

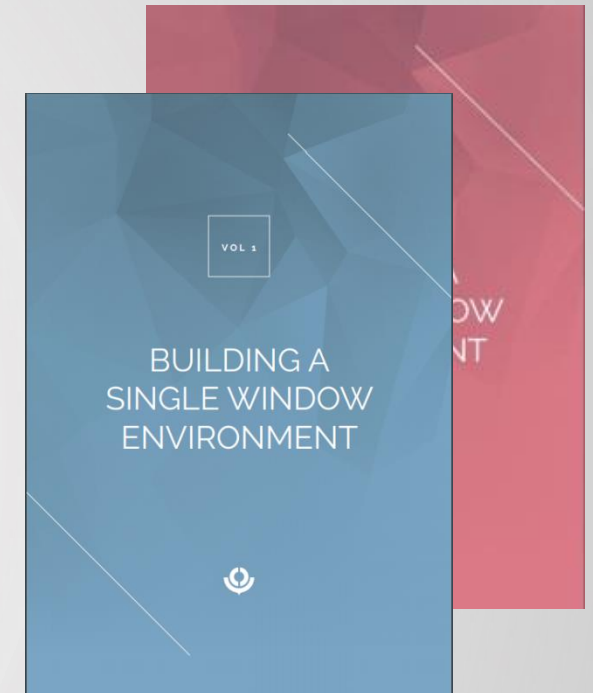

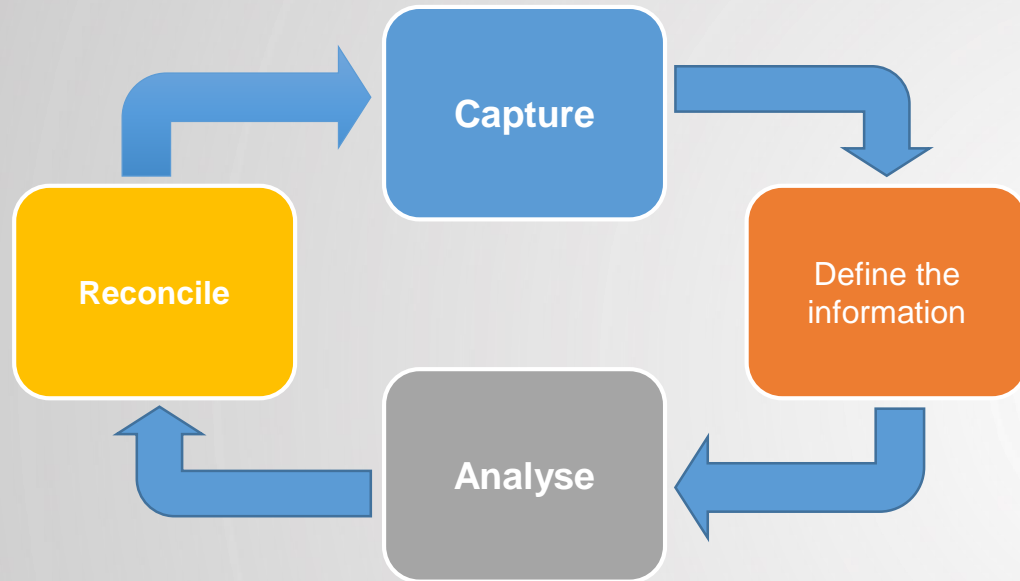


# SINGLE WINDOW COMPENDIUM

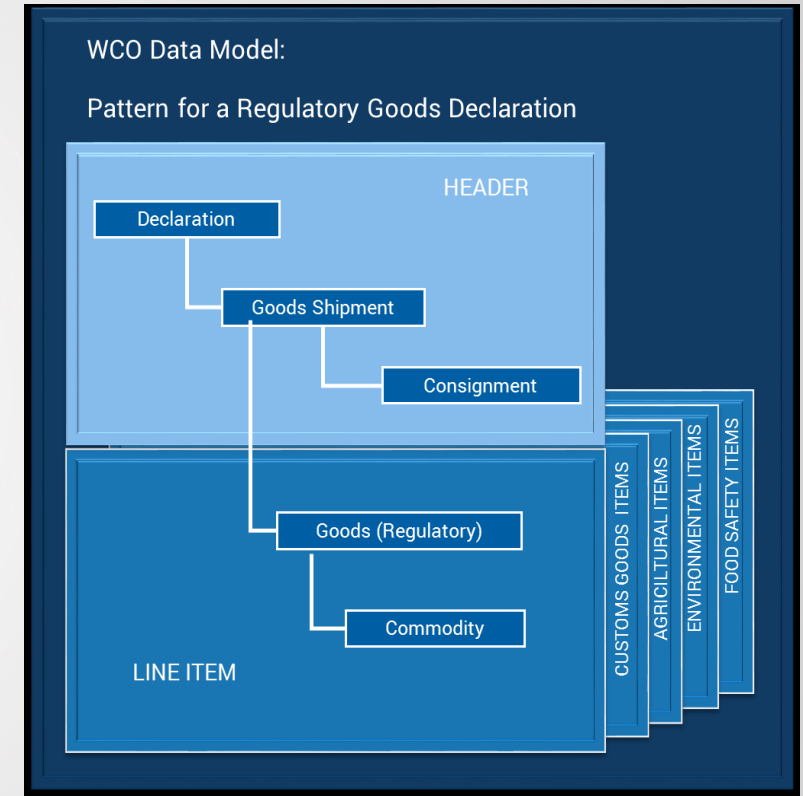
- Environment for digital collaboration
- One instance of CBM implementation:
- Services re-organized; delivered ‘under one roof’
  - Government Services to be re-engineered to meet the needs of cross-border regulatory processes
  - Cross-border Single Window is an important measure for trade facilitation
  - SW needs to be seen as an “environment” because it is not a monolithic structure, but an ecosystem of inter-dependent facilities and processes



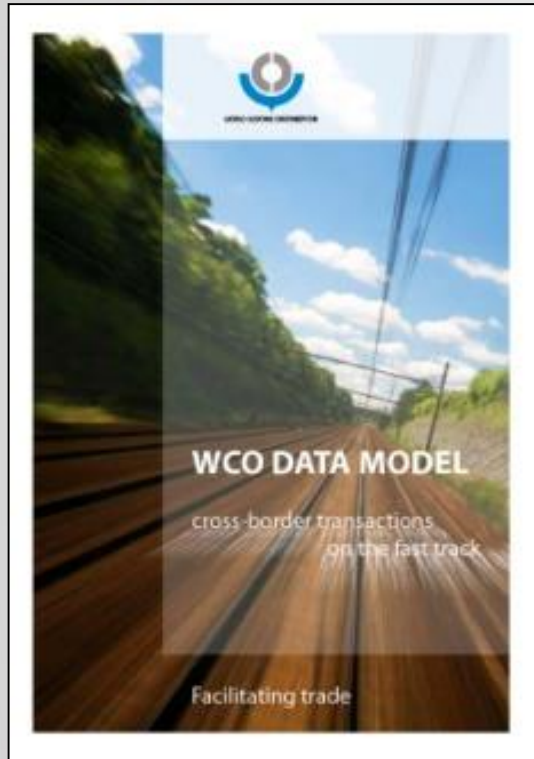
# SINGLE WINDOW DATA HARMONIZATION



- Single submission of Information is one of key functionality of Single Window
- The data harmonization exercise is necessary to eliminate redundancy of data requirement between different CBRA



# WCO DATA MODEL



- The WCO Data model is a compilation of
  - clearly structured, harmonized, standardized and reusable sets of data definitions and electronic messages
  - to meet operational and legal requirements of cross-border regulatory agencies,
  - including Customs, which are responsible for border management
- Business Process Models based on Revised Kyoto Convention (RKC)





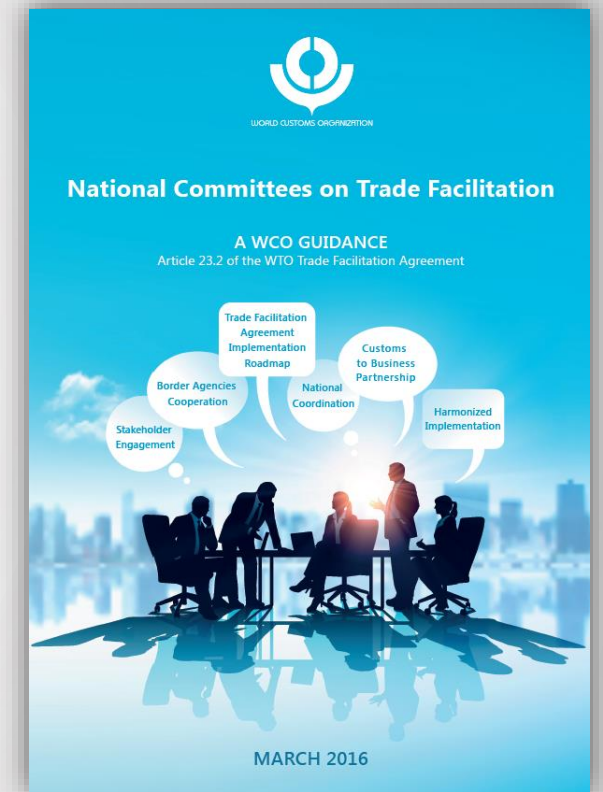
# TIME RELEASE STUDY

- “TRS is an internationally recognized strategic tool to measure the actual time taken for the release and/or clearance of goods, from the time of arrival until the physical release of cargo.”
- Performance measurement tool
- Diagnostic tool
- Monitoring tool
- Needs to include all relevant stakeholders
- Referred to in the TFA – Article 7.6
