








Representation of Participation by Region




Gender Participation in the WSIS Forum 2019



PARTNERSHIP ON MEASURING ICT FOR DEVELOPMENT

- Improving the availability and quality of ICT data and indicators, particularly in developing countries
- Guiding policy makers in producing ICT statistics that are crucial to decision-making, including the identification of a core list of ICT indicators and methodologies to collect these indicators
- Helping countries collect ICT statistics, particularly through capacity-building and hands-on training for national statistical offices, and collects and disseminates information society statistics.
- Coordinating Partnership Task Group on ICT for SDGs, co-lead by ITU and UIS as the main activity of the Partnership between 2017 to Sept 2018
- Proposing a thematic list of ICT indicators that could be used to measure ICT availability and use in sectors relevant to the SDGs that are not covered in the SDG indicators framework

UPDATES

- A first draft thematic list of ICT indicators for the SDGs was presented at the WSIS Forum in April 2019.
- After the Forum, a public consultation was held, with a comment period until the end of April.
- After this public consultation, the Task Group of the Partnership finalised the list, and submitted it to the full Partnership for adoption.
- It will be presented to the Statistical Commission in March 2020 as part of the Partnership input document to the UNSC.








ITU Contribution to the implementation of the WSIS outcomes-2019
