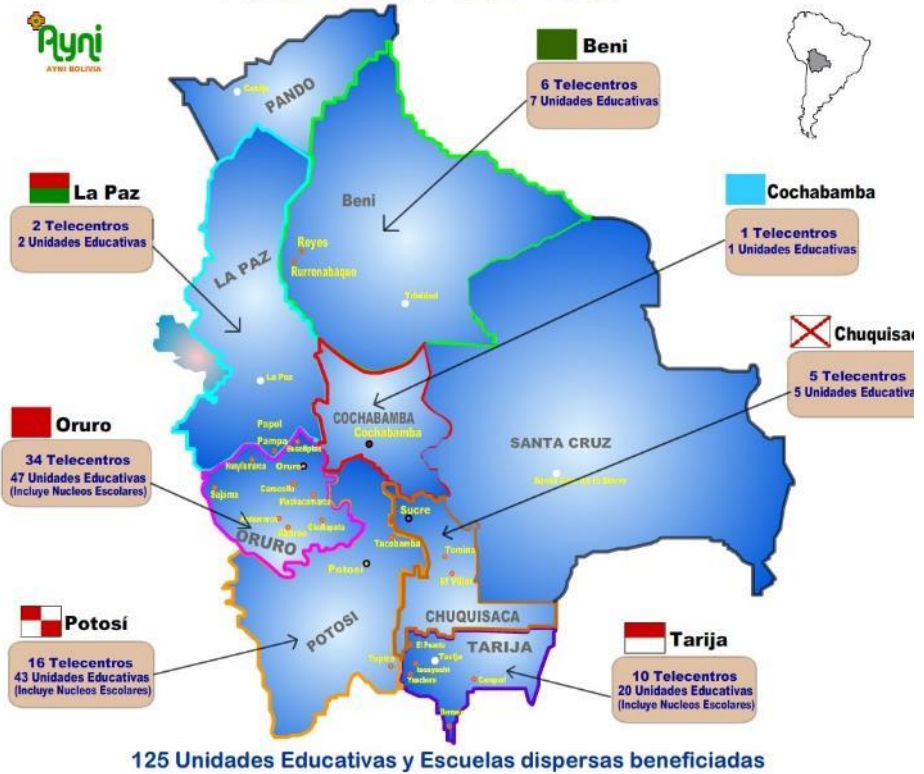


The students and teachers are equipped with IT and media skills and are then encouraged to become entrepreneurs.

74 TELECENTROS IMPLEMENTADOS AYNI BOLIVIA 1998 - 2013



► During the last years we have trained, almost 2000 students directly and 4.000 indirectly.

► Due to corona, in 2020 we only trained 835 students and 35 teachers through a Moodle platform.
