Since 1999, AYNI works on empowering students & teachers through Technology.

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



Capacity building



- During the last years we have trained, almost 2000 students directly and 4.000 indirectly.
- ▶ Due to corona, in 2020 we only trained 835 students and 35 teachers through a Moodle platform.
