
Key trends in ICT developments

 35% of world's population uses Internet (2.5 billion users in 2012)

Mobile phone subscriptions exceed 6 billion.


 Mobile broadband subscriptions exceed 1 billion and growing at 40% per year.

Global ICT developments, 2001-2013




Increase in mobile telephony


Mobile-cellular subscriptions, by level of development, 2000 and 2013 (in million)

- A key driver of growth in the ICT sector and innovation in non-ICT sectors.
- Rapid expansion of smartphones has accelerated the variety of services provided
- Leading to greater diversification of product and services

Benefits:

flexibility, costs savings and reliability

Challenges:


 privacy and security concerns, scope for local enterprises, requires high quality infrastructure and enabling legal environment.



Interactive applications

- +150 million blogs by 2011
- Facebook is visited by 40% of daily internet and Twitter by 6-7%.
- Tools for free expression and citizen journalism.
- Concerns about piracy, bullying, hate speech and intellectual property.

Growing reach of ICT applications



This has led to a greater focus on issues such as

- Information and communication infrastructure.
- Access to information and knowledge.
- Capacity-building.
- Building confidence and security in the use of ICTs.
- Role of public governance authorities and all stakeholders in the promotion of ICTs for development.
- The enabling environment.

Enhanced Cooperation

 The General Assembly (A/RES/67/195) invited the Chair of the CSTD to create a working group to examine the mandate of WSIS regarding enhanced cooperation as contained in the Tunis Agenda.

The WGEC was established in March 2013.

First meeting of the WGEC was held on 30-31 May 2013.

Internet Governance Forum


- Seventh IGF annual meeting in Baku, Azerbaijan:

- The Working on IGF improvement reported to the 15th session of the CSTD. In its resolution 67/195 the GA took note of the WGIGF report.
- Report on implementation of recommendations of the WG on IGF improvement
- Eighth meeting of IGF in Bali, Indonesia, from 22-25 October 2013.
