





- Convincing narrative
- Strategic alliances: MDBs Transport Sector
- Quick, big wins \$175 billion Rio+20 Voluntary Commitment (2012)
- Strategic opportunities Rio+20, COP21, Habitat III
- Long March through the (UN) institutions governments instrumental in scaling up
- Think (stepwise) big
- Willing to give up ego
- Accept high transaction costs multiple funders

Dedicated Secretariat doing the work for/of others

Next

- 2015 Consensus on Sustainable Development and Climate Change
- 2016 Implementation focus
- Partnerships will need to change approach from global advocacy to working with countries
- Implementation requires: Knowledge Policy Finance
- Multiple interlinked stakeholder alliances bringing on board governments + business sector
- Key is having an anchor in the UN UNCTAD?
