

- South-South Cooperation systematization exercise
 - Participation of Ibero-American countries during a specific period of time
- Cooperation Policy Instrument for the countries and the region

Gives visibility to SSC Facilitates management and decission-making







South-South and Triangular Cooperation in Ibero-America in the face of the COVID-19 crisis

The year 2020 will be marked by the COVID-19 pandemic, which has led to a health, economic and social crisis of global dimensions. This analysis explores Ibero-America's options to respond to this crisis, based on the experience accumulated for more than a decade through one of the instruments that has revealed great potential for the search of shared solutions; South-South and Triangular Cooperation.


AREAS AFFECTED BY THE COVID-19 CRISIS











THE PLATFORM AND ITS FEATURES: WHAT DID WE NEED?


FROM ANY INFORMATION SYSTEM

Registration and GATEHERING of DATA Data storage, PROCESSING and analysis REPORTING and information access


FROM THE IBERO-AMERICAN INFORMATION SYSTEM

- Features according to the Report:
 - 1. Requirements according to the conceptual and methodological framework
 - 2. Participation of different kind of actors
 - 3. Registration of data from both roles: providers and recipients
 - 4. Cross-check (validation of the data)

- Ongoing dialogue and work with the software provider
- A SIDICSS manager




ABOUT THE DATA



- Annual process of consolidation
- Each new methodological agreement implies adjusting the old data
- Data migration (2006-2015)

ANNUAL TRAININGS

- Demanded by countries and taylor made
- At least 120 officials from Cooperation Agencies and Directorates, ministries, subnational governments... trained every year
- Main topics: conceptual and methodological framework, SIDICSS and quality of information



Advantages of having a platform

COUNTRIES

- Facilitating registration
- Allows access to information that was previously unknown
- Can be used as a national or regional platform

IBERO-AMERICAN REGION

- Facilitates the data consolidation process
- Gives greater legitimacy to the final data
- Boosts capacity to store data
- Multiplies the potential for SSTC analysis in the region

KEY ISSUES

- 1. Emphasizes the dynamic nature of SSTC in the region
- 2. Increases the capacity to analyze and gain knowledge (new products, i.e. COVID)
- 3. Providing visibility (internal and external) to the countries' SSTC
- Contributes to the strengthening of the countries' institutional and methodological capacities
- 5. Reference for other developing regions (African South-South Cooperation Report y Asia-Pacific process)
