Implement and adapt the conceptual framework and measurement tools to the specific national contexts of Peru and Ecuador (DR).




Compile and report the first SSC estimates to inform and guide policy actions.

Preparing the Ground

- Mapping of National Agencies
- Data Availability and Quality Review



Establishment of an interagency coordination committee

 Create a coordination committee to oversee the SSC measurement process.
 Memorándum of understanding



Training and Capacity Building

- Organize national and regional workshops.
- Conduct study tours to countries pioneering in SSC measurement.



Pilot Testing of the Conceptual Framework

- Implement pilot studies to test the framework and measurement tools.
- Identify and address specific challenges in each country.



Compilation of Initial Estimates

 Collect and compile the first SSC estimates.



Dissemination and Expansion of Knowledge

Share tools, resources, and findings at national and international events.



Roles and Responsibilities

Int. Agencies

UNCTAD

 Develops and validates the conceptual framework, provides guidelines for data submission and receipt formats, and facilitates dissemination and reporting to the SDGs. Gobernance.

ECLAC

- Provide technical support and coordinate activities at the regional level.
- Facilitate training and capacity building.

Pilot Countries

National focal point institution

- Ministries of Foreign Affairs
- Coordinate data collection and compilation.
- Facilitate access to administrative data.

National Statistics Offices

 Support with statistical expertise, including the integration of SSC data into official statistics.

Regional consultant

 Working as link between UN Agencies and country actors, training and implementing framework.



· Actively engage in the process.
