3. **Regional and international economic cooperation** ✓

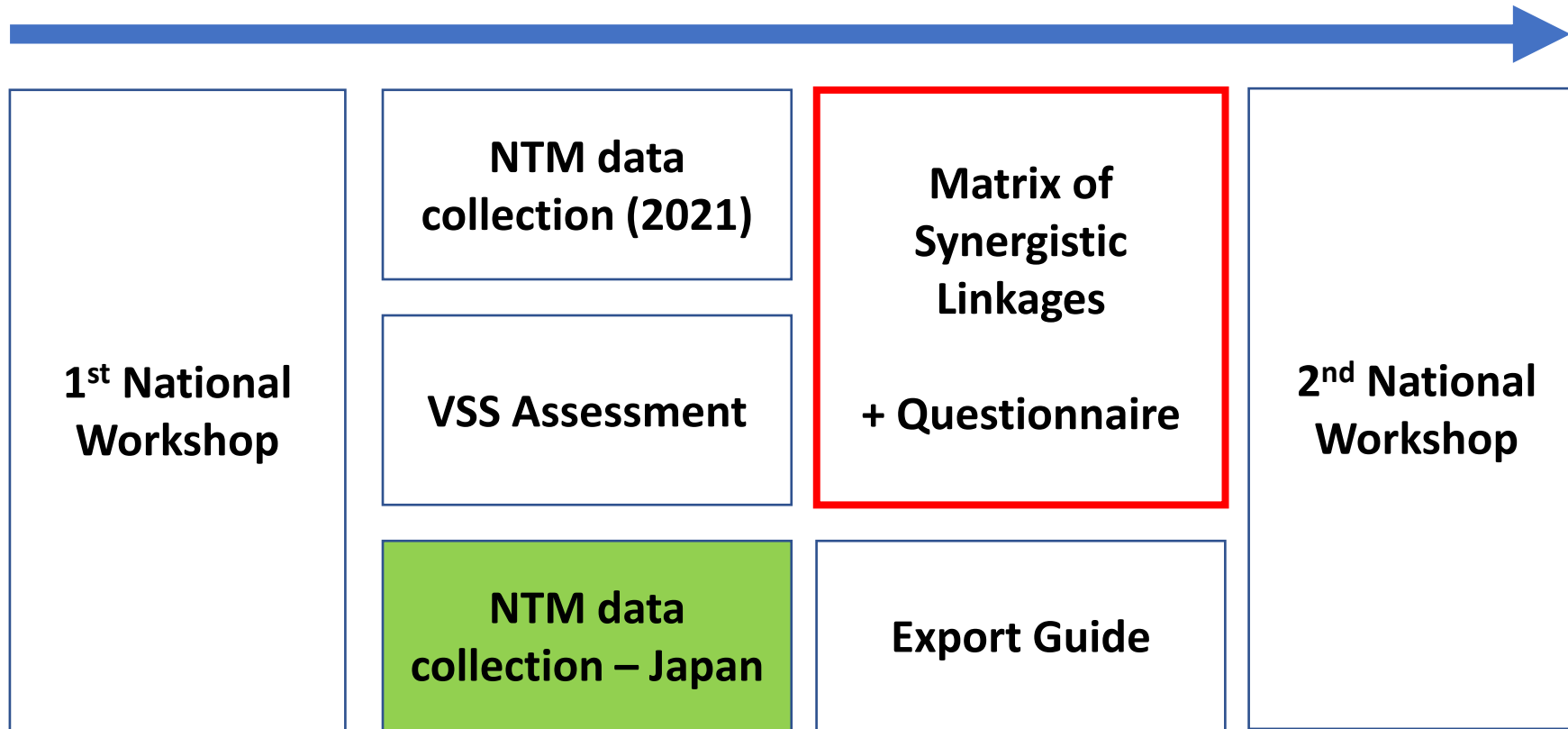

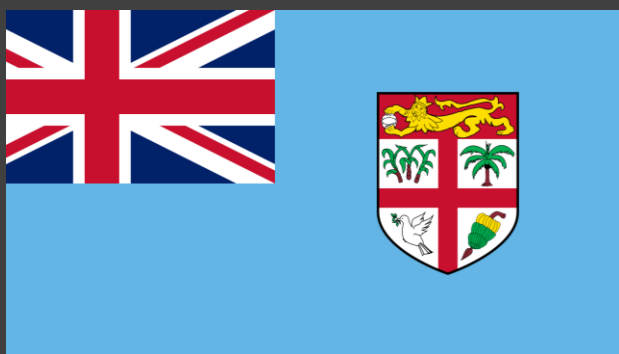
