What is capacity building?

 "Capacity-building is defined as the process of developing and strengthening the skills, instincts, abilities, processes and resources that organizations and communities need to survive, adapt, and thrive in a fast-changing world."

Why capacity building?

- Capacity building has come up a topic of discussion during national workshops
 - → Government officials and private sectors acknowledged the opportunity to get informed about NTMs
- VSS assessment reports
 - → Identified capacity building as a need for farmers and stakeholders across the value chain!



The knowledge exchange

- There is already a lot of knowledge in the region
- Is not limited to trade related areas
- → Should be wide!









Specific activities

1. Resource compilation and distribution

- Compile and share existing training materials, manuals, and other resources.
- Utilize online courses, published documents, and trainer contacts.
- Focus on both government and private sector needs.

2. Develop and conduct training sessions

- Organize skill development and knowledge-sharing sessions.
- Target SMEs, smallholders, farmer organizations, and government officials.
- Emphasize best practices in domestic and international trade.
- Partner with active organizations for broader reach.

3. Identify the needs for training

- Facilitate ongoing dialogues among MSG member states.
- Discuss and identify local training needs.
- Share information on available training programs.



Specific activities

4. Reinforce partnerships.

• Establish/reinforce relationships with regional and international organizations.

5. Develop a regional VSS platform.

- Coordinate with all MSG countries for platform development.
- Purpose: Facilitate sharing of learnings between countries.
- Establish mechanisms for regular information and capacity-building activities.

6. Dedicated "working group".

- Form a working group focused on capacity building and knowledge sharing.
- Integrate this into MSG Trade and Economic Officials Meetings (TEOM).
