Definition and Methodology


• "Non-tariff measures (NTM) are:

"Policy measures other than ordinary customs tariffs that can potentially have an economic effect on international trade in goods, changing quantities traded, or prices or both." – UNCTAD.

- NTM Data Collection Period (December 2022 March 2023)
- Methodology
 - Desktop Research (Jornal da Republica, TradeInvest, ANP, MoF, Customs)
 - In-Person Consultation
 - Expert Verification and validation



NTM Data Collection Process





NTM data results: Initial findings

292 NTM measures were identified and coded

16 different ministries and agencies were involved

12 types of NTM are collected. Three most common NTM types are:


TBT Measures



NTM Data Results: Compare to AMS








NTM data results: Product coverage

- Most regulated sectors (based on the number of regulations):
 - Animal, plants, and their products
 - Pharmaceutical and health products
 - Oil and gas, & Minerals Products
- Least regulated sectors (based on the number of regulations):
 - Artefacts
 - Aircraft
 - Ozone Depleting substances, and
 - Plastic Materials




NTM data results: Product coverage






Share between Import and Export



Across ASEAN and Timor-Leste over 62% of the measures are related to Imports and for TLS alone it`s 70%




