





Setting the scene: ITC's experience in supporting trade facilitation reforms




NTFCs' priorities have evolved since Bali

Countries with ambitious NTFCs experienced faster and more impactful reforms


2 NTFCs contributed to foster inter-agency cooperation, business perspective and 'whole-of-supply-chain' approaches in TF reforms
